FIREPAC is the IAFF's federally registered political action committee. It is funded by voluntary contributions used to support or oppose local ballot initiatives, state legislative efforts, campaigns and candidates at all levels of government. From city hall to the White House, FIREPAC supports local, state, and federal efforts to expand fire fighter influence across the country.

Who can contribute to FIREPAC

Contributing to FIREPAC is an easy way to take action that matters. It helps secure and protect rights and benefits for you, your family, and your union. Every IAFF member is encouraged to participate.

Federal law prohibits FIREPAC from soliciting contributions from anyone who is not an active or active-retired member, employee, or immediate family member.

How has FIREPAC helped

- Funded initiatives to pass collective bargaining and protect pensions on the state and local level.
- Supported pro-firefighter candidates
- Secured billions of dollars in federal funding to local fire departments through a variety of grant programs
- Passed legislation to officially recognize PFAS as a danger to fire fighters and secured PFAS blood testing for federal fire fighters.
- Defeated efforts to directly tax your employer-provided healthcare benefits
- Established a first-of-its-kind national cancer registry exclusively for fire fighters.
