Only **52%** of Christians believe the Bible is the Word of God.

86% of Christians feel confident sharing their faith, and **76%** feel responsible to do so.






While **39%** of preteens surveyed self-identify as Christian,

just **5%** display the beliefs and characteristics of a committed Christian.

Preteens whose parents read the Bible with them, or who see their parents reading the Bible, are significantly more likely to read the Bible on their own.


100% of Gen Alpha Emerging Committed Christians have Christian parents.






69% of Gen Alpha Emerging Committed Christians attend church at least weekly.


