MYSTERY MATCH-UP

Purpose:

Give your team something lighthearted to look forward to each week with a playful guessing game. You provide daily clues about a "mystery item" (school supply, pop culture reference, seasonal treat—anything goes!), and staff submit their guesses for a chance to win a small prize.

Leader Tips for Success:

- Mix It Up: Alternate between school-related and fun pop culture or seasonal picks.
- Add Visuals: Include an image hint for the final clue to boost participation.
- **Get Staff Involved:** Let staff take turns choosing the mystery item and writing clues.
- **Keep Prizes Small but Fun:** Coffee gift cards, snack baskets, or school swag work great.



Pro Tip: Start the year with an easy, inside-joke mystery item to get everyone hooked (like "the lounge microwave" or "Mr. Lee's famous stapler").

ACTIVITY DIRECTIONS

Pick Your Mystery Item: Choose something recognizable but not too obvious.

Create 4–5 Clues: Start with the most challenging clue on Monday, then get more obvious each day.

Share the Clues: Post in the staff lounge, send via email, or add to daily announcements.

Collect Guesses: Have a "Guess the Mystery Item" box in the lounge or use an online form. Limit staff to one guess per day.

End of Week Reveal & Winner: Announce the correct answer at the end of the week and draw a winner from correct guesses.

IDEAS TO CELEBRATE WINNERS

- **Prize Draw:** Pull one correct slip during Friday announcements for a small treat.
- Mystery Bag: Winner picks blindly from a grab bag of fun prizes.
- Traveling Trophy: Pass along a silly trophy (mascot, mug, etc.) for the week.
