ACTIVITY DIRECTIONS



1. Collect Items

Ask staff to submit an object (or photo) that represents them—something meaningful, quirky, or symbolic (e.g., coffee mug, ticket stub, hobby item). Make sure each one is labeled on the back or tracked privately.

2. Set Up Your Display

Before the meeting, number each item using the included stickers and arrange them on tables around the room—no names attached. Place answer sheets and pens nearby so staff can jot down their guesses as they browse.

3. Ask Staff to Guess

During the meeting, give everyone time to walk around, check out the items, and guess which object belongs to which teammate. Encourage conversation—it's a great chance for staff to connect, swap stories, and learn something new about each other.

4. Reveal & Celebrate

You can reveal the correct matches right at the end of the meeting for some laughs and "aha!" moments—or save the reveal for later in the week to keep the curiosity going. The staff member with the most correct guesses wins a prize!

Subject: Can You Guess Who's Who? – Staff Meeting Game

Hi Team,

At our upcoming staff meeting, we're going to play a fun game called "Whose Clue Is It Anyway?" It's a lighthearted way to spark connection, share some laughs, and see how well we really know each other.

Here's what I need from you:

Bring one photo of an object that represents you. It could be something meaningful, quirky, or symbolic—like a favorite coffee mug, a concert ticket, a hobby item, or a childhood keepsake. It can be a real photo printed from your phone or just something you already have on hand.

How it works:

- 1. Before the meeting, I'll display all the items around the room—no names attached!
- 2. During the meeting, we'll walk around, check them out, and guess which object belongs to whom.
- 3. I'll reveal the answers at the end (or later in the week for extra suspense).
- 4. The staff member with the most correct guesses will win a prize!

Can't wait to see what everyone brings!

ACTIVITY VARIATIONS

A few alternative ways to use the included activity.

Bulletin Board in the Lounge or Main Hallway

Turn a central space into a guessing gallery! Post the numbered photos or items on a bulletin board, along with the instructions and answer sheets nearby. Staff can swing by throughout the week to make their guesses at their own pace.

Kahoot or Google Form Guessing Game

For a digital spin, upload the photos into a Google Form or Kahoot quiz and let your staff guess virtually. This version is perfect for larger buildings or hybrid teams, and gives traveling teachers an easy way to participate. Bonus: automatic scoring makes it quick to find your winners!

Pop-Up Table in a High-Traffic Area

Set up a table in the front office, teacher lounge, or another high-traffic spot. Display the items or photos, and clip a stack of guessing sheets nearby with pens. This creates a casual, drop-by experience that invites conversation—and some friendly competition—during passing periods or lunch breaks.




Pro Tip: You know your staff best! Use this activity as-is, or adapt one of the variations to make it fit your building's style and schedule.
