

Bring out your team's competitive spirit with Three-in-a-Row Throwdown, a fast-paced, laughter-filled game where teams race to claim squares on a giant tic-tac-toe board. Each correct answer earns a spot on the board, and it takes strategy, teamwork, and a little luck to line up three in a row.

It's the perfect way to energize a staff meeting, review school trivia, or spark joy and connection across your team. Easy to prep and easy to play, this game always ends with smiles, celebration, and a stronger sense of community.

GETTING STARTED

SET UP:

- A Tic Tac Toe board (projected or drawn on chart paper/whiteboard)
- Question cards for your chosen edition (printable or on slides)
- Small teams of 3–4 players
- Whiteboards or paper for team answers
- Markers or color labels to track each team's square

HOW TO PLAY:

- 1. Each team receives one question card to start.
- 2. When you say "Go," teams race to solve or discuss their prompt.
- 3. A teammate brings their answer to you, the facilitator.
- 4. Correct answer earns a square on the board.
- 5. Missed answer means they can revise or swap for a new card.
- 6. Play for a set amount of time.
- 7. The team with the most three-in-a-row wins at the end of the game.

WHAT'S INCLUDED:

- Facilitator Directions
- Ready-to-use Tic Tac Throwdown board, 3 themed question card sets (School Spirit, Wellbeing, Speed Round)
- Score tracker and team labels



ACTIVITY VARIATIONS



1. School Spirit Edition

Questions focus on school trivia: mascot history, staff fun facts, district traditions, or school mottos.

2. Wellbeing Edition

Use the Alpaca's 10 teacher wellbeing themes to create quick reflective prompts like:

"Name one way our team supports each other."

"Share a recognition idea you've seen work well."

"What's one little win from this week?"

Teams earn squares by sharing strong examples or insights.

3. Speed Round Edition

Instead of written questions, call out quick prompts aloud (e.g., "Name a song with the word happy in it" or "What snack should we stock in the lounge?"). First correct response earns a square.

LEADER TIPS:

- Keep the pace quick—2–3 minutes per round works best.
- Mix in lighthearted and work-related questions for balance.
- Add small prizes for the winning team (coffee gift cards, snack packs, jeans pass).



Before You Play

- 1. Choose your edition: School Spirit, Wellbeing, or Speed Round.
- 2. Print or project the Three-in-a-Row Throwdown board.
- 3. Cut and shuffle your question cards.
- 4. Create teams of 3–4 staff members and hand out whiteboards or scrap paper.
- 5. Display team labels (colors, icons, or numbers) where everyone can see them.
- 6. Set the mood with upbeat music and have your score tracker ready.

During the Game

- 1. Explain the goal: "Earn three squares in a row by answering questions correctly!"
- 2. Each team receives a question card to start.
- 3. When you say "Go!", teams race to answer.
- 4. A team rep brings you their answer.
- 5. Correct: The team claims a square on the board using their color or icon.
- 6. Incorrect: They can revise or draw a new question.
- 7. Play until a team gets three in a row or until your timer runs out.
- 8. The team with the most three-in-a-row wins (or total points) is the winner.
