# Celebrating Presence Together

Attendance tells a story of community: when educators show up, they help the whole school thrive. But showing up shouldn't just be expected — it should be celebrated. This resource helps school leaders recognize consistency, reliability, and team spirit in fun, meaningful ways.

Use these ideas to bring a little sparkle to attendance goals. Whether you're rewarding individual commitment or celebrating collective "all in" streaks, these incentives turn attendance tracking into connection-building.

From quick shoutouts to team-wide treats, every idea here makes being present feel appreciated, not pressured. Find one to try with your team!



**Team Over Trophies:** Celebrate attendance as a team effort, not a personal competition.

**Lead with Gratitude:** Pair incentives with genuine appreciation: shoutouts in newsletters or morning announcements go a long way.

**Grace Over Gaps:** Be mindful of absences due to illness or emergencies: emphasize presence when possible, not perfection.

**Presence = Impact:** Connect attendance to impact: "Your presence lifts our students and your peers."

**Keep It Fresh:** Rotate reward types to keep excitement and engagement high throughout the year.

### **Staff Attendance Incentives**

Here are a few simple incentive ideas to try with your staff.

#### 1. Pick-a-Perk Passes

Each month, staff with perfect attendance draw a random perk card. Options include leaving 10 minutes early, a jeansday token, a duty swap, choosing the staff playlist, or picking the next treat for the lounge. This turns consistency into a fun surprise moment to look forward to.

**Variation:** Add a "golden" perk card that includes a bigger surprise like lunch delivery, a parking upgrade, or a snack basket for their team.

#### 2. Attendance Dare

Set a monthly attendance goal and celebrate with a playful dare when it is met. The principal completes something silly or spirited such as singing the fight song, dressing as the mascot, or hosting cafeteria duty. This turns shared progress into a moment of community fun.

#### 3. Rotating Award

Each month, spotlight a staff member who consistently shows up, supports teammates, and embodies positivity. Present a small certificate and pass along a traveling stuffed alpaca or mini trophy for their desk. This reinforces the value of reliability and teamwork.





#### 4. Team Streak Tracker

Create a hallway poster tracking attendance streaks for each team. The first group to hit 10 straight "all present" days earns a treat basket, breakfast, or a traveling trophy. This builds friendly accountability and boosts team pride.

**Variation:** Let teams name their streak to spark school spirit.

#### 5. Mystery Monday Reveal

If the staff reaches 95 percent attendance for the week, activate a Monday mystery reward. Ideas include a candy cart, hot cocoa station, or coffee delivered by the principal. This keeps motivation high as a shared goal.

**Variation:** Let staff vote on the next mystery treat once a goal is met.

#### 6. Spin-to-Win Fridays

Anyone with perfect attendance for the week gets a turn at a <u>prize wheel</u> on Friday. Fill it with snacks, coffee cards, duty coupons, or fun privileges that bring joy to the end of the week.

**Variation:** Add an "All In Jackpot" slot for a quarterly bonus prize.



#### 7. Attendance Tokens


Give small tokens such as stickers, buttons, or <u>punch-card stamps</u> each week for perfect attendance. Staff collect four to trade in for a prize drawing, badge, or recognition moment during announcements.

**Variation:** Use a different token color each month so progress feels visual and motivating.

#### 8. Attendance Bingo

Give everyone a monthly bingo board with squares tied to consistency, punctuality, teamwork, and spirit. When someone hits bingo, they earn a shoutout or prize to celebrate their effort. This keeps attendance lighthearted and interactive.

**Variation:** Try Team Bingo where grade levels or departments work together to complete their board.



**Don't Forget:** Keep the focus on fun and appreciation. The goal is to celebrate consistency in simple, joyful ways that lift spirits and build team pride.

### **Mystery Monday Reveal Ideas**

Here are a few simple ideas to try with your staff.

**Cocoa Bar:** Set up a hot cocoa station with marshmallows, whipped cream, and toppings.

**Candy Cart:** Roll through classrooms with a cart of chocolate, gummies, and sweet treats.

**Coffee Delivery:** Drop off warm coffees or flavored creamers for teams to enjoy.

**Snack Basket:** Fill a basket with popcorn, granola bars, and mini treats for the lounge.

**Popcorn Bar:** Offer popped popcorn with seasoning shakers for a fun midday pick-me-up.

**Warm Cookie Tray:** Deliver warm cookies to grade levels or set up a cookie platter in the lounge.

**Breakfast Bar:** Set out yogurt, fruit, muffins, and granola for a quick morning boost.

**Pretzel Pop-Up:** Offer warm soft pretzels with salt or cinnamon sugar.

**Soda Sip Station:** Bring in a small cooler with sodas, sparkling waters, and fun flavor add-ins.

**Mystery Drink Ticket:** Give each staff member a ticket they can redeem for a drink of their choice.

Mini Prize Pull: Let staff pick a small wrapped prize from a bowl or bag.

Jeans Day Token: Give everyone a jeans-day pass to use this week.

**Trail Mix Station:** Set up bowls of nuts, dried fruit, chocolate chips, and pretzels for a DIY trail mix break.

**Sticker or Pin Drop:** Share fun <u>teacher stickers</u> or flair pins to brighten the week.

**Treat Tasting Table:** Place small samples of snacks, candies, or dips with cute labels for staff to try.
