



# PHILANTHROPY FOR CLIMATE

## OVERVIEW

[Philanthropy for Climate](#) is a global call to all foundations, regardless of geographic location, size, or thematic focus, to integrate climate action across their work, from governance to grantmaking. What started as a public commitment from a handful of UK funders in 2019 is now a global movement of more than 900 foundations in over 20 countries, united in their commitment to integrated climate action. The movement is led locally by philanthropic networks in the UK, Spain, Italy, France, Poland, Canada, Brazil, South Africa, and the Arab Region.
