The Ocean Resilience & Climate Alliance (ORCA) is a collaborative funding alliance accelerating ocean-based responses to the climate crisis. ORCA is providing over \$350 million in new philanthropic support to a portfolio of seven initiatives spanning mitigation, carbon sequestration, adaptation, and resilience. Each focuses on areas where targeted, time-bound investment can drive meaningful progress for climate, nature, and communities, while fostering greater coordination across the ocean-climate field.

Thematic Priorities

Mitigation

Promoting ocean-based renewable energy (offshore wind development); decarbonizing the global shipping sector; and opposing the expansion of offshore oil and gas activities

Sequestration

Protecting and restoring blue carbon habitats like mangroves and seagrasses, and developing novel ocean carbon dioxide removal technologies

Adaptation & Resilience

Safeguarding vulnerable ecosystems, including the Arctic; working towards protecting 30% of the ocean by 2030; and supporting community-led adaptation efforts in the Global South, emphasizing secured tenure rights and opposition to fossil fuel expansion.

Main Engagement / Stakeholders

ORCA engages a wide network of stakeholders through funding, strategic partnerships, and collaborative action to advance ocean-climate solutions.

- **Grantee & Regranter Engagement:** ORCA provides direct funding and capacity support to NGOs, foundations, and multi-stakeholder alliances. These partners implement on-the-ground projects, develop policy advocacy, and drive technological innovation. Grantees include: *Conservation International, Ocean Conservancy, The Nature Conservancy, IUCN, Oceans 5, ClimateWorks Foundation, among others.*
- Collaborative Initiatives: ORCA works with platforms and alliances to scale
 ocean-climate action, such as the Global Offshore Wind Alliance and Renewables Grid
 Initiative, helping to coordinate cross-sectoral efforts around renewable energy and
 conservation goals.
- **Philanthropic Donors:** Major funders, including *Bloomberg Philanthropies, Builders Vision, Packard Foundation, Gordon* and *Betty Moore Foundation*, and others, support ORCA's mission by pooling resources and aligning strategies to maximize impact.
- Community and Indigenous Engagement: ORCA prioritizes funding and partnerships that elevate local and Indigenous leadership, ensuring that solutions are inclusive, equitable, and rooted in the needs of frontline coastal communities.
