Funds can be given unrestricted to the 1.5°Climate Fund for staff to assign to important organizations highlighted by the 1.5°Climate donor collaborative. There is a commitment that all of these 1.5°Climate Funds contributions will either unlock or create true matching funds,		

doubling their financial impact.
