




<p>Literacy</p> <p>For our final term in Year 3 we will be reading a chapter book called 'Oliver and the Seawigs'. Pupils will continue to develop prediction, inference, retrieval, vocabulary, explaining and summarising strategies.</p> <p>In writing, pupils will be working towards writing an adventure story. Through this they will continue to develop their use of punctuation for dialogue, prepositions, adverbs, conjunctions, powerful verbs and powerful adjectives.</p>	<p>Numeracy</p> <p>In numeracy we will be continuing to become more fluent with daily arithmetic practice. Initially in lessons we will focus on time; telling the time to five minutes, digital to analog, am and pm, moving to more complex use of time such as schedules and duration.</p> 	<p>Topic</p> <p>This half term we will be revisiting some of our previous knowledge, doing a country focus on Egypt. Children will expand on some prior learning e.g. hieroglyphics and the Rosetta Stone, as well as new knowledge of Egypt today through geography and social study.</p> 
<p>Science</p> <p>This term in science we will be exploring light. We will learn to create hyperlinks, and revise how to insert text and insert pictures.</p>
<p>Art</p> <p>This term the pupils will be learning a variety of sewing stitches and techniques including a running stitch and a cross stitch.</p> 	<p>French</p> <p>Children will be speaking in sentences, using familiar vocabulary, phrases and basic language structures in the context of subjects studied at school. They will identify and list the items found in their bag/ pencil case and the names of subjects at school. They will also speak and write sentences using J'aime and the negative Je n'aime pas.</p>	<p>P.E.</p> <p>This half term, Year 3 will have an introduction to the fundamental concepts of invasion games. We will cover key concepts of attacking, defending and possession through playing International Invasion ball (I.I.B), as well as this, we will be focussing on being a responsible teammate.</p>
