Literacy

Children will read with Miss Lily and Miss Asami once a week, verbally answering questions about the events and characters in their texts. The children will also complete short comprehension tasks to support development of their reading skills. We will also read texts as a class to promote reading for enjoyment.

This half term our writing pieces will be inspired by the picture book 'Grandad's Island'. Text types we will cover include a setting description and a non-chronological report.



We will be focusing on embedding core writing skills such as paragraphs, grammatically correct sentences and conscious vocabulary choices.



Maths

In Maths this half term we will be covering:

- Place Value of 3 digit numbers
- Using number lines
- Addition and Subtraction of 3 digit numbers
- Revising our 2, 3, 5, and 10 times tables.

Digital Literacy / Computing

In computing we will be learning about the importance of e-safety by covering a range of topics such as online profiles, online relationships, health and well-being and cyber bullying.
