The VISION of KICS is to impact the world for Christ by preparing servant-leaders who choose character before career, wisdom beyond scholarship, service above self, and a lifestyle of participation over apathy.

A KICS education establishes and prepares young students to transform their community, their country and the world.

For more of this transformation, Kigali International Community School (KICS) served over 330 students and is expanding. KICS needs a campus that is equipped to serve this vision. The land has been purchased, the design is taking shape, and now it's time to fund the new Learning Landscape and Centers of Excellence, which will allow KICS to have an extraordinary, community, national and international impact.

Together we can make this vision a reality as we prepare the leaders of today and tomorrow.

PAKISTAN: FREEDOM TO STUDY

We believe the need is evident for an oppressed group of vulnerable children to have the opportunity to experience a transformative education that could break the cycle of bondage and with this education could come freedom. We provide 80 scholarships to college students and support over 700 students with our three partner schools in Pakistan

Through transformative education, children who are forced into labor can be free to study, grow, and secure a better future for themselves.







THE GLOBAL EDUCATION GATHERING (G.E.G)

G.E.G. is a group of educators brought together from around the world who share a common goal with B2THEWORLD — to provide a transformative educational experience for children and families in countries that are recovering from war.

We bring school leaders from around the world together to learn, collaborate, and navigate the challenges that they face in their various school settings.

Aside from the training and insight from Dr. Thomas and other B2THEWORLD staff, we bring in experienced facilitators to lead impactful sessions with an emphasis on useful tips and knowledge that can be put into practice by the attendees of the gathering.

However, in 2020 we did not gather as we normally do in November due to the global movement restrictions arising from the global COVID19 pandemic.

Q&A WITH THE BOARD CHAIR



NIGEL ADAMS

Q: What prompted you to join the B2THEWORLD board?

I was introduced to B2THEWORLD and Ben in 2018 through a connection with a board member. Previously I was part of a ministry that supported and built the Sonrise School in Musanze District, Rwanda and so had some history and awareness of the needs following the 1994 Genocide against the Tutsi in Rwanda.

Later in the year, I attended an event, and there I met Ben and heard the story of how God had been with him and Susie through their personal challenges and revealed to them their calling in supporting children and communities affected by war with education and leadership resources. I was inspired by their journey and commitment.

Q: How do you envision the impact of your calling in your role as the Board Chair?

My calling and purpose are in supporting leaders and teams. God has made it clear that my calling is in supporting Kingdom stewardship and equipping ministry work both in the marketplace and in the no-profit space.

My background, training, and experience in Kingdom work have created the opportunity to support B2THEWORLD in framing and activating the vision for growth and scale as the demand for educational services and leadership development continues to expand. I'm privileged to walk alongside Ben closely and support his growth as he leads B2THEWORLD forward from a vision to a global organization with generational impact.

Q: What inspiration can you share with the team?

Simply to reinforce the value of the work that is being done and supported by B2THEWORLD. The cycles of war and violence can be broken with leadership that recognizes the value of lifting children out of oppression through education and a focus on God's plan.

However, we felt led into exploring more ways in which God is continuing to call us into greater impact. Lastly, we are exploring an exciting partnership with B2THEWORLD to expand the vision into more parts of Rwanda by starting a school for the vulnerable. STUDENT IMPACT

"My name is Sania Allahwasaya, a Medical student in the Faculty of Science. I live in a village in the Kasur area in Pakistan. My father is a factory worker and my mother is a housewife and I have four sisters and two brothers. Being a factory worker, my father's income is very low and if I didn't get this scholarship, it would not be possible for me to continue my studies. I could have lost my education. I am happy to have the opportunity to continue with my studies. I want to become a doctor in the future because I believe many people will need help. I wish to help and give them free treatment especially to very desperate people because they face very many difficulties in their life. Therefore, I wish to help others and I pray that God will help me in my mission. I am very grateful to you for providing me such an opportunity of a scholarship to fulfill my education. Thank you."

ONLINE EVENTS

Events in 2020 were like no other. However, this didn't stop B2THEWORLD from advocating for the students in Pakistan through online fundraiser events. The UNGALA was held in August while the 'FROM NEW YORK CITY TO PAKISTAN virtual gala was held in December. These were successful toward raising support for 80 college students. 

EFFECTS OF COVID19

During the year ended May 31, 2021, as a result of the spread of the COVID 19 virus, economic conditions arose which impacted the operations of the B2THEWORLD.


The Organization followed restrictions, guidelines, and other health protocols. Teacher training conferences and annual partnership site visits were canceled during the fiscal year.

Fundraising travel was not possible; however, B2THEWORLD was able to grow operations, maintain a steady cash flow, and build a cash reserve.

B2THEWORLD was able to continue operations with safety measures in place.







CONCLUSION

B2THEWORLD evaluated its May 31, 2021 financial statements for subsequent events through the date the financial statements were issued. Due to the ongoing COVID19 pandemic, economic conditions have continued which could negatively impact revenue.

Management has stated there are no issues with liquidity, and operations are expected to continue as normal in the next fiscal year. Program activities and fundraising travel are planned to resume for the coming year. Other financial impacts could occur, though such potential impact is unknown at this time.


