

Terms and Conditions: Rural Connection Adventure Passport

Register to Be in to WIN!

Simply return your completed Rural Passport during Fielddays to the Rural Support team at Site HW30. Ensure your parent or guardian completes the online form to be entered into the prize draw.

Terms and Conditions of Entry

1. Promoter

The promoter of this competition is Rural Support, located at the Health & Wellbeing Hub, Site HW30, at National Fielddays 2026 (“Promoter”).

2. Eligibility

Entry is open to individuals attending National Fielddays 2026.

All entrants under the age of 18 must have permission from a parent or legal guardian aged 18 years or older.

3. How to Enter

To be eligible for the prize draw, entrants must:

Complete the Rural Passport by obtaining a stamp from every participating site at National Fielddays 2026; and

Return the completed Rural Passport to the Rural Support site (Site HW30); and
Have a parent or guardian scan the QR code and complete the official online entry form in full.

4. Entry Conditions

Only one entry per person is permitted.

Multiple children from the same family may enter, provided each child submits a separate completed Rural Passport and has parent/guardian authorisation via the online form.

Entries must be complete, legible, and submitted in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.

The Promoter reserves the right to verify the validity of all entries.

5. Promotion Period

Entries are only valid if submitted during National Fielddays 2026, from 10 June to 13 June 2026 (inclusive).

6. Prize Draw and Notification

The prize draw will take place on or before 30 June 2026.

The winner will be selected at random from all valid entries.

The winner will be notified by phone or email using the contact details provided in the online form.

If the winner cannot be contacted within a reasonable timeframe, the Promoter reserves the right to redraw the prize.

If the prize becomes unavailable for any reason, the Promoter reserves the right to substitute it with a prize of equal or greater value.
