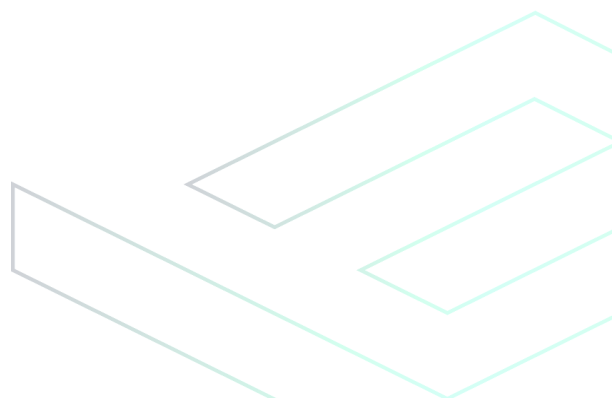

Course Overview

Participants explore core dimensions of authentic thinking and ethical AI use:

- 1. What Makes Human Thinking Irreplaceable?**
Discover why your curiosity, creativity, and judgment matter more than ever in an AI-powered world.
- 2. How AI Actually Works**
No more mystery. Understand what's really happening when you use a generative AI tool, and why that changes how you should use it.
- 3. Academic Integrity in the AI Era**
Explore what honesty looks like in the classroom right now, and why it still matters deeply to you *and* your teachers.
- 4. Using AI as a Tool, Not a Shortcut**
Learn the difference between AI as support and AI as a substitute, and why that line matters for your growth.
- 5. Prompting with Purpose**
Move from passive user to intentional thinker. Strong prompts lead to stronger thinking.



6. Thinking Critically About AI Outputs

AI can be wrong, biased, or incomplete. Learn to treat its responses as a starting point, not a final answer.

7. Citing & Verifying Sources

Build the research habits that keep your work credible and your name protected.

8. Showing Your Work

Documentation isn't just for math class. Learn how to make your thinking process visible and protect yourself in the process.

9. Navigating Evolving Classrooms

Policies are changing fast. This module helps you adapt with confidence across different courses and schools.

10. Your Personal AI Ethics

Design a thoughtful, flexible approach to AI use that grows alongside your values for life, not just for school.

- Tell the difference between your own thinking and AI-generated content
- Use AI for brainstorming and support without letting it replace your ideas
- Spot inaccuracies and evaluate AI responses with a critical eye
- Properly cite sources and bring transparency to your work

- Document your creative and academic process clearly
- Build a personal code of ethics around AI that goes beyond the classroom

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
