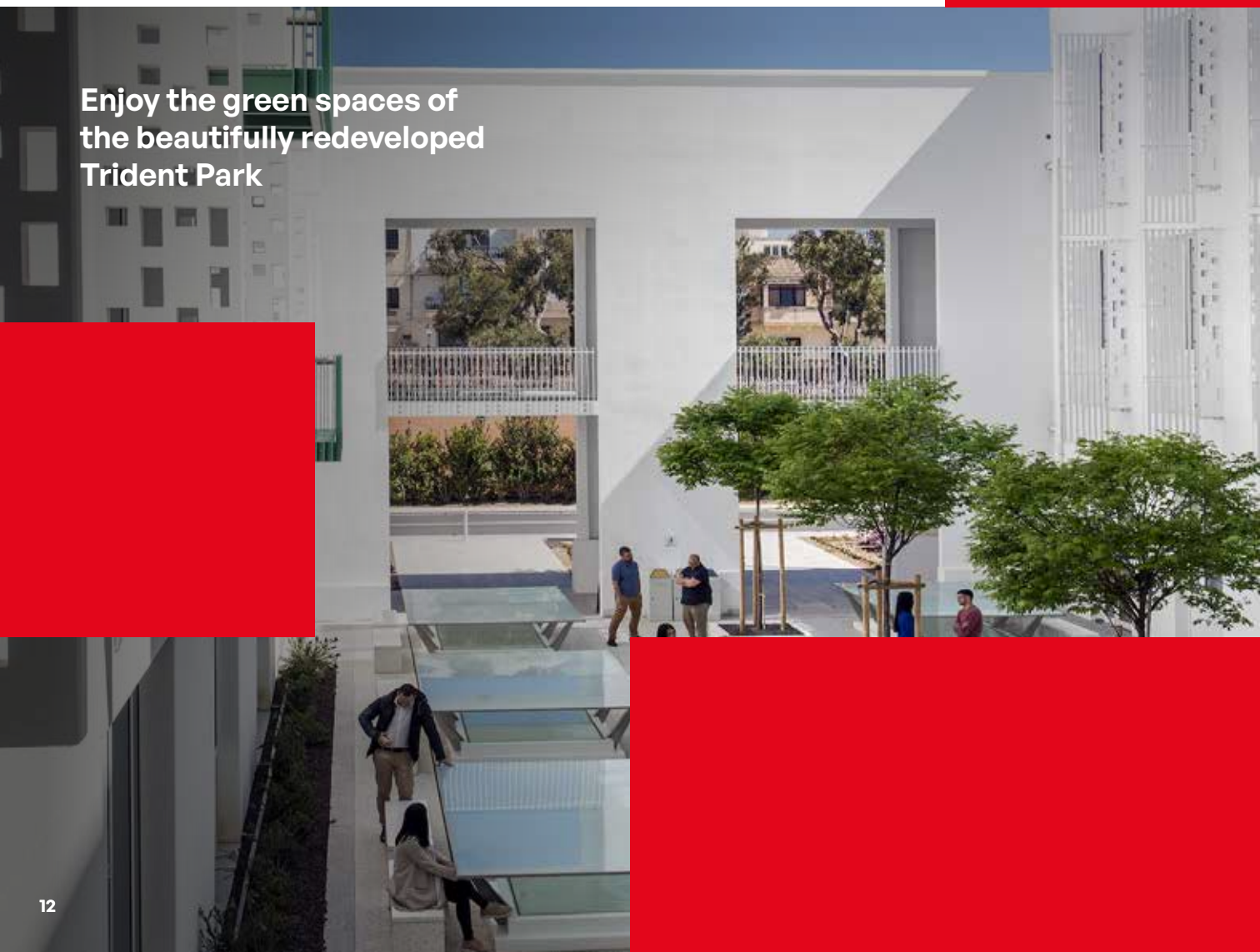

Janine Bosak is a Full Professor in Organisational Psychology/Behaviour and HRM at Dublin City University Business School. Janine served as Executive Committee Member of the European Association of Work and Organizational Psychology (EAWOP) from 2017 to 2022 and she currently serves as elected PDW chair of the Academy of Management (AOM) Careers Division (executive board).

She completed her PhD with summa cum laude at the Department for Psychology, University of Bern (Switzerland). During her doctorate, Janine worked at Northwestern University (USA) and at the University of Cambridge (UK) as a visiting research scholar. Prior to joining DCU as a lecturer in 2009, she also worked at the Universities of Bern and Fribourg in Switzerland and was a visiting Research Fellow at Boston University (USA) in 2015 and a James M. Flaherty Visiting Professor at HEC Montreal (Canada) in 2016. Janine is currently a Visiting Professor at the Capital University of Economics and Business in Beijing (China).

Janine was Research Director of the Leadership and Talent Institute (LTI) from 2016–2023 and Director of Doctoral Studies from 2014–2019. She is currently the Business School EDI Committee Chair and Programme Director for the MSc in Work and Organizational Psychology/Behavior programme. Janine is also the winner of the 2025 President's Excellence Award in PhD supervision at Dublin City University. Janine conducts research, teaches and consults in the areas of Women and Leadership and Employee Well-being in Organizations. She is also a certified and trained business coach who advances the systemic and solution-focused approach to coaching.

Janine has published in journals including Journal of Organizational Behavior, Personality and Social Psychology Bulletin, Human Resource Management (US), Human Resource Management Journal, and British Journal of Management. Her research programme has attracted several fellowships, grants and awards from bodies including the European Science Foundation (ESF), Swiss National Foundation (SNF), German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD), Society of Personality and Social Psychology (SPSP), and the Ireland Canada University Foundation (ICUF).

Currently, Janine is a Consulting Editor of the Journal of Occupational and Organizational Psychology (JOOP) and the European Journal of Social Psychology (EJSP). She serves on various editorial boards (e.g. HRMJ, JPP, JOEPP). She is also a member of the Academy of Management, the European Association of Work and Organisational Psychology, and the European Association of Social Psychology.

Patrick C. Flood is a Full Professor of Organisational Behaviour at Dublin City University (DCU). He received his PhD from the London School of Economics and completed post-doctoral work at London Business School. He has taught in Malta on the MSc in Work and Organizational Psychology with KNIGHTS. He is a Fellow of the Royal Society of Arts and a former Chevening Scholar, Fulbright Scholar, EU HUMCAP Scholar, Erskine (NZ) and CRH Scholar. He holds teaching and research excellence awards from DCU and University of Limerick and has served as Head of Department and Assistant Dean. Faculty and visiting appointments include London Business School, University of Maryland, Frankfurt School of Finance and Management, Cambridge University, Rotterdam School of Management, Northeastern University, PRC and Capital University of Economics and Business. He has worked in Africa, Australia, China, Europe, UAE and USA on company, executive and MBA programmes.

He has been named #8 in the HR Most Influential listing. His research focuses on CEO leadership, high-performance teams and organisational change, attracting over E2m in research funding. He has published over 100 publications in journals like the Journal of Management and Human Resource Management. His 13 books include Outsider Leadership and Change Lessons from the CEO, among others. Patrick has consulted with over 30 organisations, including Adidas, AstraZeneca, HP and Intel.

He currently teaches on executive programmes at Cambridge, Frankfurt, and Rotterdam.

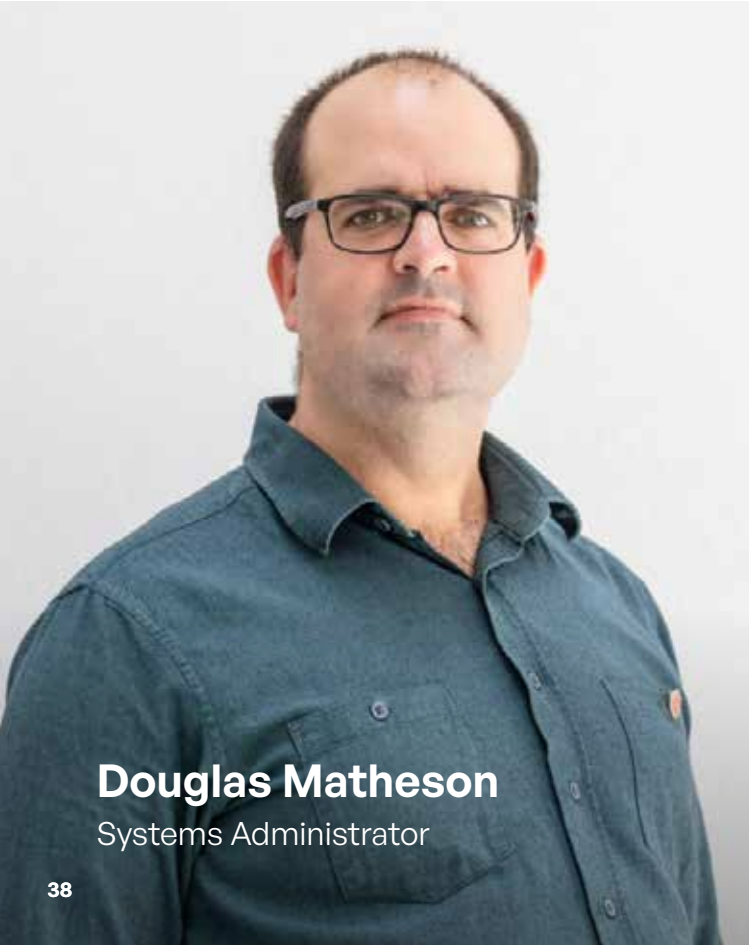

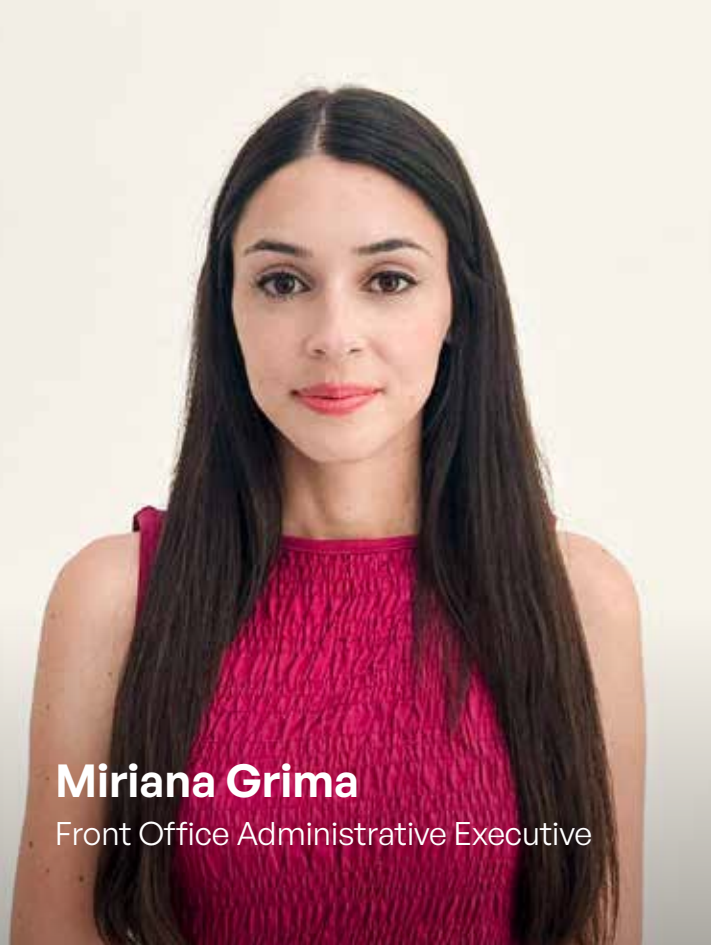

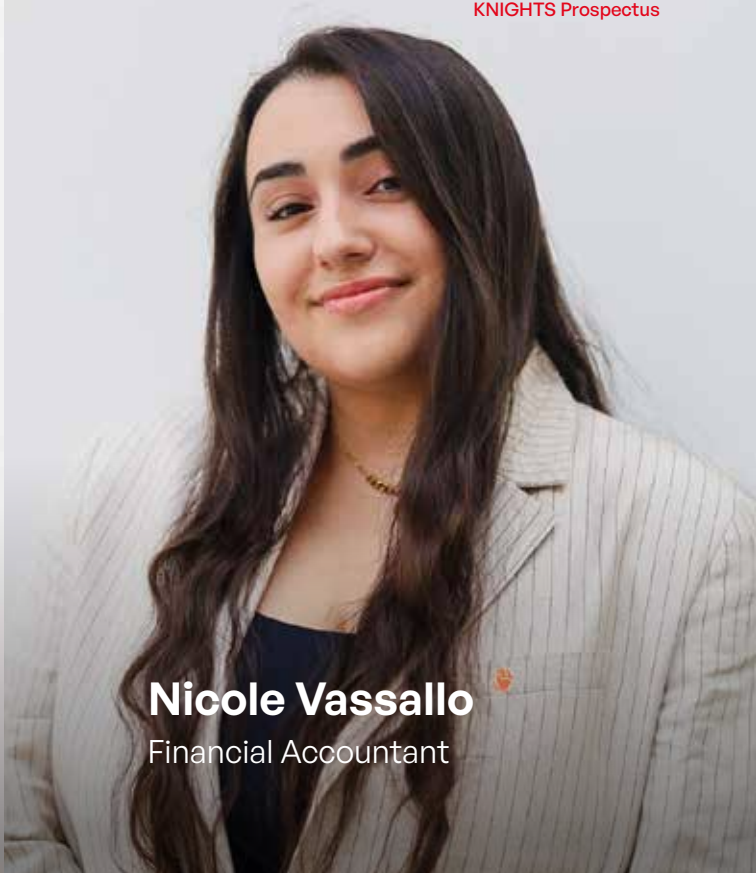

In the absence of a Maltese Embassy or Representation in your country, please contact us by email so that we may contact the central immigration authorities on your behalf and provide you with the necessary information about your visa application procedure. It would be useful to include your student reference number in your correspondence.

Following your arrival in Malta, you shall be guided and assisted by the Student Support Office to apply for a residence permit (please refer to the section titled

‘e-Residence Permit for non-EU/EEA nationals’), which would be valid for one year of study and is renewed every year subject to your academic progression.

Please ensure that important documents are packed in your hand luggage. You might be requested to present these important documents before you board your flight to Malta. You may also be asked to present them to the immigration authorities in the transit country or upon arrival in Malta. Most airlines will ask you to present a return ticket to your home country and an insurance policy of a certain duration. You should ask about these when applying for the visa and booking the flight ticket.
