FOR (durante)

*No estará aquí **hasta** la semana que viene.*



We waited there **for** five hours.
*Esperamos allí **durante** cinco horas.*

DURING (durante)

Many trees fell down **during** the storm.
*Muchos árboles cayeron **durante** la tormenta.*



Some animals hunt **during** the night.
*Algunos animales cazan **durante** la noche.*

FOR VS DURING

We lived in Canada **for** five years.

*Vivimos en Canadá **durante** cinco años.*

*En esta frase expresamos **cuánto tiempo** duró la acción de vivir en Canadá.*



During the first year we moved house 4 times.

***Durante** el primer año nos mudamos 4 veces.*
