

Sprawling on the edge of the northern Kenyan frontier, stretching from the slopes of Mt Kenya to the rim of the Great Rift Valley, lies one of Africa's most pristine and untouched wilderness areas, the Laikipia region.


Embark on an exciting journey to photograph one of the rarest big cats in Africa – the stunning Black Leopard.

For the most part, the chances of spotting a black leopard in the wild has been reserved to the forests of India, where most of the black leopard images we've seen in the past have come from.

"Black" leopard sightings, and tales thereof, have been somewhat of a legend across various parts of Africa...... until now!!!! In 2018, a series of camera-trap images surfaced and caused great excitement for photographers across the world. Nestled deep within the Laikipia Plateau of Kenya a small population of black leopards was discovered.

Over the past years, local guides and trackers have spent day-after-day in the field, absorbing everything they can to understand the movement and territories of these amazing big cats. This has resulted in regular and consistent sightings.

This photo safari is designed to take you to the heart of black leopard territory to experience and photograph one of Africas rarest big cats.

Laikipia is world-renowned for its black leopard sightings, one of the rarest and most captivating experiences in the animal kingdom. These melanistic cats have made Laikipia their home, and this trip offers a unique opportunity to photograph them.

A particular female black leopard, born and raised just 100 meters from the camp, is regularly sighted and remarkably relaxed around vehicles. With early morning and afternoon/night safaris, you'll have unrivalled potential to photograph these magnificent cats.


Six spacious tented rooms complement central dining with indoor and outdoor living areas giving snug warmth and views of the stunning Laikipia Landscape.

Cost:

Our safari experience is priced at \$8500 per person sharing. Single supplement is \$1250. Please note that any bank charges incurred during the payment process are not covered by Tusk Photo. We kindly request the full amount indicated on the invoice, including any fees imposed by Paypal if you choose to use this payment method.

Deposit:

To secure your reservation, a 50% deposit of the full price is required within 14 days of making your booking. Once we receive your deposit, your booking will be confirmed. Please make sure to complete this step within the given timeframe to secure your spot.

Balance:

The remaining balance is due at least 9 weeks prior to the safari. If you are making a booking within 9 weeks of the safari, the full price will be payable at the time of booking.

Cancellation Policy:

We understand that plans can change, and in the event of a cancellation, the following fees will apply unless Tusk Photo is able to fill your safari space:

- Cancellation more than 120 days prior to departure: 10% of the full price
 - Cancellation 90 119 days prior to departure: 40% of the full price
 - Cancellation 60 89 days prior to departure: 70% of the full price
- Cancellation less than 60 days prior to departure: 100% of the full price

Please note: Your travel plans are made entirely at your own risk, and Tusk Photo cannot be held responsible for any flight cancellations, disruptions, or delays that may occur. We recommend considering travel insurance to protect your investment and provide peace of mind.

DAY 1


- •Meet at Wilson Airport and take our flight to Laikipia.

Flights and Transport

- Check-in is one hour prior for domestic departures and two hours prior for international departures.
- Please make sure to check on your relevant passport visa requirements for Kenya. All RSA passport holders now require a visa to enter Kenya and their can be obtained online at https://www.etakenya.go.ke/en
- Many scheduled regional flights may involve multiple stops before reaching final destination.
- On arrival after clearing customs and immigration in Nairobi, we recommend you take a taxi to Wilson airport. There are many taxis available as you exit the airport.

Photography and Gear

It is not advisable to take photographs of border posts or military/ police posts. Doing so can lead to an unpleasant situation and even arrest. Always ask permission before taking a photograph of the any local African residents; it is a sign of respect. In most cases a small payment is expected. However some cultures believe that the camera steals their soul and we request that you respect and understand their beliefs.

It is advisable to bring the following camera equipment:

- 2x Camera bodies (a backup will mean peace of mind)
- Spare memory cards and batteries
- Long telephoto lens 400/500/600
- Medium telephoto lens 70-200 or equivalent
- Wide angle lens(es) 24-70 / 14-24
- Flash and battery pack is advisable although optional
- Notebook or additional storage device
- Camera trap equipment (Optional)

Please remember that it is very likely that you could possibly photograph thousands of images over the 6 day period. We therefore strongly advise you to have sufficient storage and battery arrangements in place. If you are unsure of anything please contact us for more details

Tour Info

INSURANCE

Travel Insurance:

While it is highly unlikely, there is a possibility of scheduled flights in and out of your destination being delayed due to unforeseen circumstances. To provide peace of mind and cover any potential flight disruptions or missed connections, we strongly recommend purchasing additional travel insurance.

• Medical Insurance:

For your safety and well-being, we highly recommend having medical insurance that covers unforeseen medical emergencies and evacuation. Please let us know in your booking form whether you have taken out any medical insurance for this safari.

Travellers 83 years and older will need to arrange their own comprehensive travel insurance.

PASSPORTS AND CUSTOMS

- Passports are required by all foreign visitors and must be valid for 6 months after the intended length of stay. Please ensure that there are two blank pages per country to be visited.
- South African citizens require no visas to enter Botswana.
- It is advisable to declare any cameras, lenses, laptops and other valuable items when leaving
 your country. We normally recommend keeping a detailed list of all items including serial
 numbers and descriptions. This makes the customs process that much quicker as all that is
 generally required is for the customs official to stamp the document.



MONEY AND CURRENCY

- The currencies accepted in Kenya are, Kenyan Shilling (KES) and US Dollars (USD) USD will need to be exchanged in some instances at local rates.
- Banks and foreign exchange bureaux are available at all international airports and in all main towns.
- Credit card payments can be processed at the camps.
- US dollars are widely accepted; however, notes dated before 2003 are no longer accepted.

HEALTH

- Please consult your physician before you travel for advice on precautions against malaria.
- Should you require additional advice, we suggest you contact your local travel clinic for consultations regarding Malaria and the Immunisations required for travel to Kenya.
- Yellow fever certificate may be required.

LANGUAGES

• The official language of Kenya is English, Kiswahili (Swahili) is the national language. There are also various tribal languages spoken throughout the country. Almost everybody involved in the tourism industry, either directly or indirectly, will be able to speak some English.

DIETARY REQUIREMENTS

We understand the importance of accommodating diverse dietary needs, and our team is dedicated to ensuring that we can cater to most dietary requirements. Please provide us with any specific dietary needs in your booking form.

POWER AND ELECTRICITY

220v battery power (charged by the generator / solar) is used for lighting in guest tents 24hrs a day.

220v plugs available in each tent for the charging of batteries only. Hence bring spare battery, charging unit and adaptors. Universal Power Plug Adaptor (Kenya uses UK-type plugs)



CLIMATE

Kenay has a rainy season from November to May, with a break in January and February. November and December have "short rains" with temperatures around 27°C (81°F) in the afternoons. January and February see less rainfall but occasional showers. March, April, and May bring long rains, with April being the wettest month and cool mornings at around 13°C (55°F). The dry season lasts from June to October. Days are warm with occasional showers, while nights can be cold due to varying altitudes. June, July, and August are sunny and dry, with afternoon temperatures reaching 25°C (77°F). Evenings and early mornings are chilly, around 12°C (54°F). September and October are dry with some possible rain. October temperatures can reach 27°C (81°F), but rain may cause a decrease.

Average rainfall varies throughout the year: around 10 rainy days per month during the dry season, about 15 days during the short rainy season, and approximately 21 days during the long rainy season.



CLOTHING AND WHAT TO PACK

For a memorable safari experience, we suggest opting for comfortable, casual wash-and-wear attire. To enhance your game-viewing experience, it is advisable to choose muted colours. Keep in mind that game-drives are typically conducted during the early morning and late afternoon, which can be quite cold, particularly in winter.

To ensure you are well-prepared, we recommend packing the following practical items for your safari:

- Comfortable, casual wash-and-wear clothes in muted colours.
- Long-sleeved shirts for sun and mosquito protection.
- T-shirts for layering.
- Shorts or light skirt for warmer days.
- Jeans or safari trousers for cooler evenings.
- Bring a jacket and sweater for chilly morning and evening game drives.
- Pack a lightweight, waterproof jacket for potential afternoon showers.
- Wear comfortable walking shoes.
- Essential items: sunblock, sunglasses, hat, insect repellent, moisturiser, lip balm.
- binoculars and camera equipment.
- Good quality safari clothing (we opt for Craghoppers Nosilife)

GRATUITIES

Please note that the following gratuity amounts are provided as a minimum guideline, and you are welcome to increase them if you wish:

- Ranger / Guide USD 20 per person per day
- Camp staff USD 10 per person per day

CONNECTIVITY & EMERGENCY CONTACT DETAILS

The phone code for Kenya is +254. Telecommunications are relatively good in Kenya and mobile phones will work in many areas of the country although you will need to ensure that international roaming is enabled by your mobile provider. Reasonable Wifi is available at all three camps. For Main Camp this is in the Wifi hut, for River Camp and Palm Camp this is in the central areas. If you have access to a local sim or you are happy roaming we also have limited reception in camp. Please ask the team and they will show you the best spot for reception.
