







Cost:

Our safari experience is priced at <u>US\$ 9,690</u> per person sharing. <u>US\$ 2200</u> Single Supplement. Please note that any bank charges incurred during the payment process are not covered by Tusk Photo. We kindly request the full amount indicated on the invoice, including any fees imposed by Paypal if you choose to use this payment method.

Deposit:

To secure your reservation, a 50% deposit of the full price is required within 14 days of making your booking. Once we receive your deposit, your booking will be confirmed. Please make sure to complete this step within the given timeframe to secure your spot.

Balance:

The remaining balance is due at least 9 weeks prior to the safari. If you are making a booking within 9 weeks of the safari, the full price will be payable at the time of booking.

Cancellation Policy:

We understand that plans can change, and in the event of a cancellation, the following fees will apply unless Tusk Photo is able to fill your safari space:

- Cancellation more than 120 days prior to departure: 10% of the full price
 - Cancellation 90 119 days prior to departure: 40% of the full price
 - Cancellation 60 89 days prior to departure: 70% of the full price
- Cancellation less than 60 days prior to departure: 100% of the full price

Please note: Your travel plans are made entirely at your own risk, and Tusk Photo cannot be held responsible for any flight cancellations, disruptions, or delays that may occur. We recommend considering travel insurance to protect your investment and provide peace of mind.

Itinerary

- Day 1: Arrival in Windhoek, check-in at River Crossing Lodge.
- Day 2: Drive from Windhoek to Keetmanshoop for a photo session of Quiver Trees.
- Day 3: Depart Keetmanshoop for Luderitz, accommodation at Luderitz Nest Hotel.
- Day 4: Explore the Kolmanskop Ghost Town.
- Day 5: Travel from Luderitz to Sossusvlei, overnight at Dead ValleyLodge.
- Days 6 & 7: Explore landscapes and wildlife at Sossusvlei.
- Day 8: Drive to Swakopmund, check-in at the Beach Hotel.
- Day 9: Morning charter boat tour in Walvisbay, followed by afternoon photography at Pelican Point and/or Flamingos.
- Day 10: Morning desert experience, followed by photography at Pelican Point and/or Flamingos.
- Day 11: Depart for Etosha, stay at Okaukuejo.
- Days 12-14: Wildlife game drives and night photography at Etosha National Park.
- Day 15: Return to Windhoek, allowing time for international flights home. End of the tour.

Flights and Transport

- To reach Windhoek, the capital city of Namibia, there are two primary options: self-driving or flying. If you choose to embark on a self-drive adventure, you'll have the flexibility to explore the picturesque landscapes along the way. The journey to Windhoek typically involves crossing the border from neighbouring countries, such as South Africa or Botswana. Ensure you have the necessary documents, including valid passports and driver's licenses, as well as any required permits for your vehicle. Familiarise yourself with the local road regulations and be prepared for long stretches of driving.
- Alternatively, flying to Windhoek is a convenient and time-efficient option. Numerous airlines
 offer flights to Windhoek, and it is advisable to book a flight departing after 3 pm on the day
 your tour ends to allow ample time for any unforeseen delays or last-minute activities.
 Whether you choose to self-drive or fly, Windhoek awaits with its vibrant culture and natural
 wonders.



Photography and Gear

It is not advisable to take photographs of border posts or military/ police posts. Doing so can lead to an unpleasant situation and even arrest. Always ask permission before taking a photograph of the local and any Namibia residents; it is a sign of respect. In some cases a small payment is expected. However some cultures believe that the camera steals their soul and we request that you respect and understand their beliefs.

It is advisable to bring the following camera equipment:

- 2 or 3 Camera bodies (a backup will mean peace of mind) with spare batteries.
- Long telephoto lens 400/500/600
- Medium telephoto lens 70-200 or equivalent
- Wide angle lens(es) for landscapes and hide photography
- A good sturdy tripod for landscapes and use around waterholes etc. in Etosha.
- Ground pod / Skimmer plate for low angle and star trail work is very handy.
- For long lenses we recommend using a Wimberley Gimbal head (or equivalent) and for landscapes a good ball head.
- Flash (Optional: Off-shoe cord / flash bracket / Better Beamer especially for Etosha waterholes)
- For some of the more difficult shots & flash work we will be using remote triggers. We recommend Pocket Wizard Plus III with
- camera and flash cables. The PW Plus III will trigger both camera and flash and therefore is our recommended choice here.
- Release cable and or intervalometers Canon TC80N3 for Star trail work. Nikon's have built-in intervalometers.
- Notebook or additional storage device.

INSURANCE

• Travel Insurance:

While it is highly unlikely, there is a possibility of scheduled flights in and out of your destination being delayed due to unforeseen circumstances. To provide peace of mind and cover any potential flight disruptions or missed connections, we strongly recommend purchasing additional travel insurance.

Medical Insurance:

For your safety and well-being, we highly recommend having medical insurance that covers unforeseen medical emergencies and evacuation. Please let us know in your booking form whether you have taken out any medical insurance for this safari.

PASSPORTS AND CUSTOMS

- Passports are required by all foreign visitors and must be valid for 6 months after the intended length of stay. Please ensure that there are two blank pages per country to be visited.
- South African citizens require no visas to enter Botswana and Namibia.
- It is advisable to declare any cameras, lenses, laptops and other valuable items when leaving
 your country of origin. We recommend keeping a detailed list of all items including serial
 numbers &descriptions. This makes the customs process that much quicker as all that is
 generally required is for the customs official to stamp the document. This is important when
 returning to your country of origin or home country

MONEY AND CURRENCY

- The currency of Namibia is the Namibia Dollar N\$
- In Namibia you will be able to use South African Rand (ZAR) as legal tender. The exchange rate is 1:1 with the ZAR
- Banks and foreign exchange bureaux are available at all international airports and in all main towns
- Credit card payments can be processed at most places in Botswana and Namibia.
- US dollars are widely accepted; however, notes dated before 2003 are no longer accepted. Also, high denomination notes may not be accepted.

HEALTH

- Namibia is a low-risk Malaria area.
- Please consult your physician or local travel clinic before you travel for advice on precautions against malaria and other possible diseases

LANGUAGES

• The national languages in Namibia is English and Afrikaans. However German is also widely spoken.

DIETARY REQUIREMENTS

POWER AND ELECTRICITY

220v plugs available in each tent / room for the charging of batteries — These plug points are rounded 3 point such as South Africa's standard.

CLIMATE

The climate in Namibia is hot and pleasant during the summer months. Rainfall peaks between Nov ember to March. Winters are generally mild with cool mornings and evenings



CLOTHING AND WHAT TO PACK

For a memorable safari experience, we suggest opting for comfortable, casual wash-and-wear attire. To enhance your game-viewing experience, it is advisable to choose muted colors. Keep in mind that game-drives are typically conducted during the early morning and late afternoon, which can be quite cold, particularly in winter.

To ensure you are well-prepared, we recommend packing the following practical items for your safari:

- Comfortable, casual wash-and-wear clothes in muted colors.
- Long-sleeved shirts for sun and mosquito protection.
- T-shirts for layering.
- Shorts or light skirt for warmer days.
- Jeans or safari trousers for cooler evenings.
- Bring a jacket and sweater for chilly morning and evening game drives.
- Pack a lightweight, waterproof jacket for potential afternoon showers.
- Wear comfortable walking shoes.
- Essential items: sunblock, sunglasses, hat, insect repellent, moisturizer, lip balm.
- binoculars and camera equipment.
- Good quality safari clothing (we opt for Craghoppers Nosilife)

GRATUITIES
