



Reducing Barriers to Participation

The Edmonton Warriors Soccer Club is committed to ensuring that all players have the opportunity to participate, regardless of financial circumstances. The Club will not deny registration due to an inability to pay fees and offers several options to help offset costs:

- Volunteer Opportunities: Families can contribute volunteer time, which may be applied as a credit toward player fees.
- Hardship Fund: Funded through grants, registration fees, “Sponsor a Player” programs, and other donations, the hardship fund provides financial support to players and families who require assistance with registration fees.

The Club encourages families in need of financial support to take advantage of one or both sponsorship programs, helping to reduce or cover registration costs and ensure that every player can participate.



KidSport supports players and families needing financial assistance with sport registration fees. Applications are accepted throughout the year and grants are administered to sport clubs, at up to \$250 per kid/year. <https://kidsportcanada.ca/alberta/edmonton/>
