The following shall now read –

**Junior Domestic
Point Ranking System For Representative Players**

The Player Points Ranking System is a way of trying to ensure a more even A grade domestic competition and ensure a better quality of competition for all clubs.

1. **Total Team Points (TTP)** – 9 points per team from U8-U15 boys and girls inclusive

Summer Domestic Season

For the Summer domestic season (October-March) the PPR shall be calculated on the just completed VJBL Representative Basketball season.

Winter Domestic Season

For the Winter domestic season (April- September) the PPR shall be calculated on the current VJBL Representative Basketball season.

2. **The Player Points Ranking (PPR)**

Victorian Championship (VC/VCR)	- 3 points
VJBL1 - 3	- 2 points
VJBL 4 +	- 1 point

- a) A player who transfers from one club to another will incur a one point penalty which remains for four seasons. Transferred players are never deemed to be a Homegrown Player. Players who transfer prior to beginning to play VJBL do not carry a transfer player PPR, but will never be a Homegrown player.
- b) For the purpose of player replacement or injury, a team may replace any player within the By-Law restrictions provided the total TTP of all players registered to that team for the season is not exceeded. The TTP for a team for each game shall not exceed 9 points.
- c) A player who has been recruited to play in a VJBL Representative Basketball team any time after the start of the VJBL grading season carries no points for that current domestic season.
- d) A quitting VJBL player will carry points as if they had completed their current season of VJBL basketball.
- e) Domestic players playing up an age group will carry the same PPR as would normally apply.
- f) If the second representative team in an age group qualifies for VC, they will receive PPR points as if they had qualified in VJBL 1.

- g) A player who begins playing domestic basketball at Kilsyth but already plays representative basketball for an association other than Kilsyth will carry the Base Rate PPR. After 4 seasons of playing for their first Kilsyth domestic club, they will be considered a Homegrown player at that club.

3. Player Loyalty Variations

Bonus for Homegrown VJBL Representative Basketball Player: Deduct one point from their PPR. A Homegrown Representative player will have a minimum PPR of one point.

A Homegrown Player is defined as having played for NO other Kilsyth Basketball club, no matter which age group they joined that club (ie. From U7 to U23).

Failure to adhere to the above will mean the loss of ladder points for every game the team is over the Total Team Points.
