

MESSIANIC PROPHECIES



Matthew wrote to a primarily Jewish audience, so the messianic predictions of Old Testament prophets would have meant a lot to those reading his account of Jesus’s life. Matthew, along with Luke, emphasized how Jesus’s birth and life fulfilled prophecy. The fulfillment of these messianic prophecies would have supported his claim that Jesus really is the Messiah, the Son of God sent to become the Savior of the world.
