VBS/VBX VOLUNTEER DESCRIPTIONS 2026

Check-in/Greeters: Start the day with joy! Welcome families, assist with kiosk check in, and help mornings run smoothly. Serve time: 7:00–9:00 a.m.

Preschool: Create a warm, playful environment for volunteers' little ones (Birth–PreK). Support teaching, crafts, recreation, and music in a nurturing setting. Contact our Preschool Minister, Karen Walls, at kwalls@fbccov.org for more information.

Snacks (VBS/VBX Kids): Keep kids fueled and happy! Deliver snacks to K–6th classrooms by 10:00 a.m.

Special Friends Buddy: Be a steady, encouraging companion to a child with special needs. Meet them in the Special Friends Suite, help them find their class, and stay as long as they desire. VBS Crafts: Bring creativity to life! Assist with prep and guide K–3rd graders through engaging craft projects that reinforce the day's lesson. Volunteers will rotate to various rooms helping kids make creative and fun projects. Be prepared to do a lot of walking.

VBS Bible Teachers: Lead or co-lead Bible lessons for K–3rd graders, follow the daily schedule, serve alongside Tour Guides, have gospel conversations, and help ensure each child is safely released at check-out. Volunteer must be a member of FBC Covington.

VBS Recreation: Bring the fun to life! Work alongside our Recreation Coordinator—who keeps kids laughing, moving, and fully engaged—to set up, run, and clean up exciting games for K–3rd graders. Expect lots of smiles and a joyful atmosphere.

VBS Tour Guides: Be the friendly guide kids look forward to seeing. Escort K–3rd graders to rotations, assist teachers, and help ensure safe dismissal each day.

VBX & VBX Music & Motions: Bring the energy! Help lead upbeat worship songs and motions for K–6th graders, making each rotation lively and memorable. *(must be high school age or older)*

VBX Crafts: Bring creativity to life! Assist with prep and guide 4th-6th graders through engaging craft projects that reinforce the day's lesson. Volunteers will rotate to various rooms helping kids make creative and fun projects. Be prepared to do a lot of walking. *(must be high school age or older)*

VBX Bible Teachers: Lead or co-lead 4th–6th grade preteens through Bible lessons, serve alongside Tour Guides, have gospel conversations, group discussions, and ensure each preteen is safely released at check-out. Volunteer must be a member of FBC Covington. *(must be high school age or older)*

VBX Recreation: Bring the fun outside! Help set up and run high energy games, keep the action moving, cheer on preteens, and refill water coolers around campus. Expect sunshine, sweat, and tons of laughs. *(must be high school age or older)*

VBX Tour Guides: Welcome preteens each morning, escort them through rotations, assist teachers, and ensure every preteen gets safely to the right adult at check-out. *(must be high school age or older)*
