Are you new to Laneway or festivals in general?

This festival guide is designed to give you everything you need to know in order to have a safe and fun day at Laneway!

BEFORE THE EVENT

Check the weather on the day and make sure you dress to suit. (hat, sunglasses, raincoat, comfortable shoes etc.)

Make sure you plan your trip getting in and out of the festival.

Important: if you show up to the event intoxicated, you will not be allowed to enter



HOW TO GET TO LANEWAY

The Festival Entrance on Kennedya Drive is only a 15 minute walk from Joondalup station and all public transport on the day is included with your Laneway ticket. Visit <https://www.transperth.wa.gov.au/Journey-Planner> to plan your public transport.

We will have a Car/Rideshare drop off and pick up point on Moore Drive (westbound only) from the west of Joondalup Drive intersection.
Approach from Grand Boulevard.

We do not recommend driving as parking is severely limited.

Please allow extra travel time getting to and from the festival.

YOUTH ENTRY

You must be 16 or older to attend Laneway Festival.

All 16 and 17 year olds **MUST** be accompanied and supervised, at all times, by a **Responsible Adult** over the age of 18 years old.

Register your Responsible Adult on the Laneway App

Present to the registration tent at the front gates (BEFORE you enter the festival) and fill out a wristband with your guardian / or your minor (if you're the guardian) name / phone number - put this on and please wear it all day!


Enter the Youth + Guardian entry lane, present your ID, and have your ticket scanned. You will then get an Entry wristband to head into the festival!



WHAT I NEED TO ENTER LANEWAY


Required for festival entry:

- ✓ A valid ticket (saved to your digital wallet or have it in the Ticketek app on your phone)
- ✓ Valid Photo ID - check ID Requirements on our website for accepted forms of ID



RECOMMENDED ITEMS TO BRING

- ✓ Empty *soft* water bottle - there are lots of water refill stations located on the site so you can stay hydrated
- ✓ Hat, sunglasses, sunscreen (travel sized) - be sun smart!
- ✓ Credit/debit card/phone wallet - we're cashless!



ACCESSIBILITY- INFO

ACCESSIBILITY DROP OFF/ PARKING

ACROD Permit holders may pick up and drop off and park at the designated ACROD Permit parking area at Arena Joondalup.

Please use Waabiyn Way, approaching from Moore Drive (westbound direction only).

Please have your ACROD Permit ready and follow all directions from Traffic Controllers and Event Staff.

ACCESSIBLE VIEWING PLATFROM

Laneway provides Accessible Viewing Decks and designated viewing areas for patrons with disability (including non-visible disability) and their companions. These spaces are designed to support people who need clearer sightlines and room for mobility aids.

As these areas are limited, if the deck reaches capacity, priority will be given to wheelchair and mobility-aid users and patrons who require access-supported viewing to participate fully in the event.

We really appreciate everyone's support in helping us keep these areas available for the people who rely on them most.

ACCESSIBILITY - LOW SENSORY SPACE

Our events are held in outdoor spaces and feature large crowds, loud noises, and are exposed to weather and uneven surfaces.

If you feel overwhelmed, or require additional support (but you don't require medical attention), please make your way to our low sensory spaces that are indicated on the patron map.

We also have a variety of alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks available at our bars.

Please bring an empty *soft* water bottle to fill up at our water stations and take lots of breaks in the shade.
