Prerequisites:

- 46 hours of PIC cross-country flight time
- FAA Private or Commercial Pilot Certificate
- Online ground school completed
- FAA Knowledge Test passed
- Valid FAA Medical Certificate or BasicMed

If additional training is required, aircraft and Certified Flight Instructor time are available at FFTC's current published rates. If the rating is completed before all included flight hours are used, the remaining hours may be used for time building or aircraft rental.
