

# Privacy Policy Notice September 2025

# 1 APPLICATION

Thank you (hereinafter the "Website visitors", "potential clients", "active clients", "client", "other individuals", "individuals", "your", "data subjects" as appropriate) for using www.b2prime.com (hereinafter the "Website"). The website is owned and operated by B2B PRIME SERVICES MENA LIMITED, (hereinafter the "Company", "we", "us", "our" as appropriate).

This Privacy Notice applies to all personal data relating to identifiable individuals ("Data Subjects") that we collect and process through our Website <a href="www.b2prime.com">www.b2prime.com</a> and in the course of our regulated activities. The Website is operated by **B2B Prime Services MENA Limited** ("the Company", "we", "us", "our"), a DIFC-registered entity authorised and regulated by the **Dubai Financial Services Authority (DFSA)**.

By using our Website or engaging with us, you acknowledge that you have read and understood this Privacy Notice. If you do not wish your data to be processed in accordance with these terms, you should refrain from submitting personal information.

# 2 POLICY STATEMENT

We are committed to complying with all applicable data protection obligations under the DIFC Data Protection Law No. 5 of 2020 ("DP Law 2020"), the associated Regulations, and the relevant DFSA Rulebooks, including obligations relating to the fair treatment of clients, confidentiality and safeguarding of client information. This Privacy Notice explains how we collect, use, store, disclose and protect your personal data, and outlines your rights under DIFC law.

Your privacy is of utmost importance to us and it is our policy to respect and safeguard the confidentiality of information and your privacy. This Privacy Policy Notice sets out how the Company collects, uses and manages your personal information we receive from you or a third party in connection with our provision of services to you or which we collect from your use of our services and/or our website and/or any other related websites and applications. The Privacy Policy Notice also informs you of your rights with respect to the processing of your personal information.

# 3 INTRODUCTION

B2B Prime Services MENA Limited, incorporated in the DIFC and licensed by the DFSA, must collect and use personal data of Website visitors, potential clients, active and former clients, and other individuals who interact with us. The processing of such data is undertaken strictly in accordance with DP Law 2020 and our regulatory obligations.

Personal data refers to any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person, including identifiers such as a name, identification number, online identifier, or other factors specific to that individual.

# 4 PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

We collect and process personal data on lawful grounds, including: compliance with our legal and regulatory obligations; the performance of a contract or steps taken prior to entering into a contract; protection of our



legitimate interests; and, in some cases, based on your consent.

The data collected may include identity documents, contact information, financial and professional details, information about trading activity, risk profile, communication records, and technical data such as IP addresses.

We may also obtain information from third parties, such as introducers, service providers, regulators, or public sources.

Personal data is used to verify identity, construct client profiles, perform due diligence, monitor transactions, provide services, comply with regulatory obligations, and manage our relationship with you. We take appropriate measures to ensure security and confidentiality at all times.

#### 5 ANALYTICS

We use analytics services from third parties to help analyze how the users use the Website. These analytics services use cookies, scripts, and other technologies to collect and store information such as how users interact with the Website, how often users visit the Website, what pages of the Website the users visit, and what other sites the users used prior to coming to the Website.

# **6 FOR HOW LONG THE WE KEEP YOUR PERSONAL DATA**

We retain personal data for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes for which it was collected and in compliance with legal and regulatory requirements. As a DFSA-regulated firm, we are required to retain client records for at least six (6) years from the termination of the business relationship, or longer if required by law. Once this period expires, data will be securely deleted or anonymised..

# 7 SUBJECT TO CONSENT

By using our Website, registering with us, or providing us with personal data, you consent to the collection, processing, storage and disclosure of your information in line with this Privacy Notice. You may withdraw your consent at any time by contacting us, though please note that in some cases processing is required for us to provide services or comply with regulatory obligations.

#### 8 PROCESSING FOR OTHER REASON

We will ask to receive data subject's consent in any case we will process data subject's personal data for a purpose other than that for which personal data have been collected.

# 9 DATA SUBJECTS RIGHTS

Under the DIFC DP Law 2020, you have a number of rights, including the right to access your personal data, to request rectification of inaccuracies, to request erasure under certain circumstances, to restrict processing, to object to processing (including marketing), to request portability of your data, and not to be subject to automated decision-making that significantly affects you.

# 10 IP ADDRESS

We may collect information about your computer, including, where available, your IP address, operating system browser type, for system administration and to report aggregate information to our advertisers. This is statistical data about our users' browsing actions and patterns. We use this information for the operation of the Website, to maintain quality of the Website and to provide general statistics regarding use of the Website.

#### 11 RECORDING OF COMMUNICATIONS

We record, monitor and process any telephone conversations and/or electronic communications between the Company and you. information, you have the opportunity in an easy manner and free of charge to object to the use of your contact details, by automatically opt out of receiving further promotional emails, newsletters and other emails containing marketing information.

We recognize the importance of guarding the security of your personal information and on-line communications.
