

Early Years Support Assistant

Job Description

Hours	16 hours a week initially over 3 days (Mon, Tues and Wed) to support a child in setting with additional needs. Hours 8.30 to approx. 1.30/2pm
Responsible to:	Early Years Lead Practitioner and SENCO

Main Duties:

- To work closely with and look after a child in setting requiring additional support.
- To work alongside and under the instruction of the settings SENCO
- Support will include helping with personal care and snack and lunch times.
- To provide an enabling environment whilst giving the support and care as outlined in the child's Individual Support Plan (ISP).
- To ensure the safeguarding and welfare of the individual child and all other children at all times.
- To make and keep records as required
- To build and maintain positive relationships with the child's parents.
- To adhere to and follow the setting's policies and procedures.
- To undertake any training that is required.
- To ensure confidentiality is maintained at all times
- To liaise, and work in partnership with, and attend meetings with parents and any outside agencies involved as required.
- To undertake any other duties as deemed necessary by the Setting Manager and or Senco.
