DROP OFF AND COLLECTION ROUTINES

Now that our children are settled into nursery, we are really focusing on our drop-off and collection routines, especially in line with our safeguarding procedures.

When dropping off and collecting the children, parents are welcome to come into the entryway and help your children in dropping off their belongings. We would like from now to ask parents to not enter the nursery rooms and just drop off their child at the gate. This helps for a quick transition for the children into nursery and allows them to settle more quickly. At drop off, please let a member of our team know who will be collecting your child and what time to expect you. This helps us to reassure children when it comes to collection time, and also assists in our safeguarding procedures so that we know who to expect at the gate.

All families should now have received a Collection List to complete with additional adults who have permission to collect your child/children. We have asked each family to set a password for collection, so that our team is able to confirm the identity of the adult collecting your child. If an adult comes to collect that is not known to us, we reserve the right to refuse collection and will contact a parent to collect in this scenario.

You are welcome to add additional adults to the approved collection list at any time. Please ask Beth or Emily to request an additional form.

PLEASE NOTE: any late collection that is after your child's session has finished will be subject to late fees as per your nursery contract. Please let us know in advance where possible if you will be late to collect, so that we are aware of when to expect you.
