



Books play a crucial role in children's growth in a variety of ways—emotionally, intellectually, socially, and even physically in some cases. As part of Nevada Hands & Voices' mission to support, encourage, and educate families with Deaf and Hard of Hearing (DHH) children, we are proud to offer our *Growing Book by Book* Lending Library. This resource, funded in part by the Nevada Early Hearing and Detection Intervention (EHDI) Program, is designed to help DHH children and their families continue in their growth to reach their full potential through literacy. The *Growing Book by Book* Lending Library is a collection of books available to Nevada Hands & Voices families for free. There are hundreds of books to choose from for all readers, including books featuring different languages, modalities, hearing technology, with Deaf and Hard of Hearing characters and by Deaf and Hard of Hearing authors. Many books are available as recommended by the Hands & Voices O.U.R. Children's Safety Project, Hands & Voices CIRCLE of Change, and the American Society for Deaf Children.

Research shows that reading and signing stories together helps promote essential literacy skills for ALL children: deaf, hard of hearing, *and* hearing. Each book in our NVHV Lending Library has a QR code to take you to the ASL Stories Directory to find the corresponding video.
