## ENT Doctors & Audiologists

Ear, Nose, and Throat (ENT) physicians are medical doctors who diagnose and treat conditions affecting the ear, nose, and throat. They evaluate medical causes of hearing loss, manage ear health, and may perform medical or surgical procedures.

Audiologists are hearing specialists who perform hearing evaluations, diagnose hearing loss, fit and manage hearing technology such as hearing aids or cochlear implant processors, and monitor hearing over time.

ENT physicians and audiologists often work together and may practice in the same clinic or medical facility to provide coordinated care for children who are Deaf or Hard of Hearing.

# School Programs for Deaf and Hard of Hearing Students

School programs for students who are Deaf or Hard of Hearing provide specialized educational services, communication access, and support accommodations. These programs work with families and educators to ensure students receive appropriate services, assistive technology, and accessible learning environments through IEP or 504 plans.

Families must contact their **local school district special education department or case management team for evaluation and placement** before enrolling in a Deaf or Hard of Hearing program. IEP teams determine appropriate placement and services based on evaluation results and the student's Individualized Education Program (IEP).
