Now that might have something to do with the Blarney Stone, the legendary Stone of Eloquence, found at the top of our tower. 60 acres of surprises, delights and mysteries lead visitors through various gardens, arboretums, and avenues.

	<b>Cobh Titanic Trail</b> - A gentle guided walking tour of the town of Cobh in Cork Harbour (Titanic's last port of Call). Truly amazing insights into the stories of RMS Titanic and Lusitania Fabulous overview of maritime heritage of Cobh and Cork Harbour. #### **Cancellations and Refunds**

You are not entitled to any refund, payment, compensation, or credit except as otherwise provided in this Section. Any refunds will be made directly to the method of payment you used at the time of booking or your travel agent and you must receive your refund directly from these sources. Guests who cancel in writing as set forth below within the dates shown below for any reason, including medical or family reasons, are subject to the following per-person cancellation fees, as applicable.

You hereby agree that losses sustained by Prime Tours in the event of your cancellation would be very difficult or impossible to quantify and that the fees set forth in the below cancellation schedule represent a fair and reasonable assessment as liquidated damages. Since a cancellation likely means a diminished opportunity to sell the same space on other cruises or trips, the cancellation fees below apply regardless of a name change or stateroom resale.

All requests for cancellation must be received in writing. Cancellations cannot be made online.
