Saturday	September 5, 2026 - NYC - Club Quarters World Trade Center
	Flight from CMH to NYC
	Arrive in NYC. Transfer to Club Quarters World Trade Center and lunch on own.
	We begin with a self-guided visit to the 9/11 Memorial and Museum , a deeply moving tribute honoring the nearly 3,000 lives lost on September 11, 2001, and sharing powerful stories of resilience and unity.
	Later, we check in to the Club Quarters World Trade Center , a modern hotel perfectly situated in Lower Manhattan with sweeping city views and easy access to iconic landmarks.
	The evening is yours to enjoy—perhaps take in the magic of a Broadway show, where dazzling lights and world-class performances bring unforgettable stories to life.
Sunday	September 6, 2026 - St John's - Delta Hotels St. John's Conference Centre (B)
	We fly to St. John's, Newfoundland , where colorful row houses, a lively harbor, and rich maritime heritage welcome us to this charming coastal city.
early morning	Breakfast boxes delivered. Check out of the hotel and load motorcoach for airport transfer.
	Flight to St. John's
	After arrival, we check in to the Delta Hotels St. John's Conference Centre for a 3 night stay, offering modern comforts and a central location within walking distance of shops, restaurants, and waterfront views.
	Dinner is on your own this evening—enjoy a relaxed meal at the hotel or explore one of the many nearby eateries serving fresh, local flavors in festive George St area.
Monday	September 7, 2026 - St John's - (B, D)
	Buffet Breakfast at the hotel
9:00 AM	We set out on a guided tour of St. John's , discovering its vibrant streets and storied past. At Signal Hill , take in sweeping views of the Atlantic and learn about the site's role in military history and the first transatlantic wireless signal. We pass the stately Government House and the Confederation Building, symbols of Newfoundland and Labrador's heritage, along with the bustling campus of Memorial University.
	Midday, enjoy lunch and shopping on your own in downtown St. John's , where colorful storefronts and welcoming locals make every stop a delight.
	In the afternoon, we journey to Cape Spear Lighthouse National Historic Site , the easternmost point in North America. Standing at the edge of dramatic cliffs, you'll feel the power of the Atlantic Ocean and explore the oldest surviving lighthouse in Newfoundland, a beacon that has guided ships since the 1830s.
	This evening, gather for a group welcome dinner at Yellowbelly Brewery , a historic brewpub housed in a building that survived the Great Fire of 1892, serving locally inspired dishes alongside handcrafted ales in a warm, inviting atmosphere.
Tuesday	September 8, 2026 - St. John's - (B, L)
	Breakfast at the hotel
9:30 AM	Today we set off on the Excursion Around the Bay , venturing beyond St. John's into the picturesque outports and fishing villages that dot Newfoundland's coastline. Along the way, we'll wind through rolling hills, pass sparkling coves, and hear captivating tales of the province's fishing heritage, seafaring traditions, and resilient communities. Each stop offers a glimpse into authentic Newfoundland life—from colorful clapboard houses to weathered boats bobbing in quiet harbors—set against the backdrop of the wild and beautiful Atlantic.

	Meet Rhonda Lane at the Gander International Airport ~ During the events of 9/11, Rhonda worked as a border services officer at the Gander airport. Guests will visit the North Atlantic Aviation Museum and take a guided tour of Gander including the Silent Witness Memorial to the 256 passengers and crew of flight 1285R carrying US Army personnel on their return from a peacekeeping mission back to the home base in Ft. Campbell, Kentucky, who all perished when the plane crashed just after takeoff on Dec 12, 1985. The tour will also stop at Gander Town Hall to hear director Brian Williams' personal story of that day and see one of the 3 pieces of the Twin Towers in Newfoundland.

Cancellations and Refunds

Guests who cancel in writing as set forth below within the dates shown below for any reason, including medical or family reasons, are subject to the following per-person cancellation fees, as applicable.

You hereby agree that losses sustained by Prime Tours in the event of your cancellation would be very difficult or impossible to quantify and that the fees set forth in the below cancellation schedule represent a fair and reasonable assessment as liquidated damages. Since a cancellation likely means a diminished opportunity to sell the same space on other cruises or trips, the cancellation fees below apply regardless of a name change or stateroom resale.

All requests for cancellation must be received in writing. Cancellations cannot be made online. Cancellations received 180 days or more prior to departure, or as stated in your trip flier, are refundable less an administrative fee of a minimum US \$50 per person, or as stated in your trip flier.
