Fri, May 14	Fly Day (D)
	Depart Cleveland Airport for direct AerLingus flight to Dublin, Ireland. Dinner and Breakfast on flight.
Sat, May 15	Dublin 1 night (B) RIU Gresham Hotel - 4 star
	Arrive at Dublin Airport Terminal 2. Meet our driver/guide at International Arrivals.
	Your visit to Ireland begins at the beginning ~ the Hill of Tara . Tradition identifies the hill as the inauguration place and seat of the High Kings of Ireland and in Irish mythology. Tara consists of numerous monuments and earthworks—dating from the Neolithic to the Iron Age—including a passage tomb, burial mounds, round enclosures, and a standing stone believed to be the "Stone of Destiny."
	Depart for Dublin City Driving Tour followed by lunch on your own in the Grafton Street Trinity College area. <i>Optional add-on - Trinity College Library & Book of Kells self-guided tour.</i>
	Visit Guinness Storehouse Museum for complementary pint and best views in Dublin. If you want to truly immerse yourself in the unique history, heart and soul of Ireland's most iconic beer, there's only one place to go – its home. The Guinness Storehouse, built on the grounds of the 9,000 year lease signed and sealed in 1759 by Arthur Guinness himself, contains seven unforgettable floors of sights, sounds and sensations in a building that has been brewing beer for over 250 years. Hopping with entertainment, this experience takes you on an immersive experience from grain to glass.
	Check in for your 1 night stay at the 4-star RIU Gresham Hotel on O'Connell St, in the heart of bustling Dublin City.
	Join Brandy and the Prime Tours staff in the hotel bar for a welcome pint or glass of wine. This is at your leisure and optional.
	Rest of evening and dinner at your leisure. Enjoy a meal at the hotel restaurant or explore the many options on O'Connell St. or at the nearby Temple Bar. Be sure to take a photo from the Ha'Penny Bridge while you're there.
Sun, May 16	Killarney 3 nights (B, L) International Hotel - 4 star
	Full Irish Breakfast at the hotel.
	Depart Dublin and head to Killarney via Kilkenny .
	Tour Kilkenny Castle , free time or Smithwick's Brewery Tour - guest choice. Founded soon after the Norman conquest of Ireland by Richard de Clare, 2nd Earl of Pembroke, commonly known as Strongbow, the Castle has been rebuilt, extended and adapted to suit changing circumstances and uses over a period of 800 years. One of the best fully furnished castles in Ireland.
	Welcome Lunch at Kytler's Pub , the 3rd oldest pub in Ireland established in 1324 by Dame Alice de Kytler, daughter of a Norman lord. Alice was later accused of witchcraft and while she escaped, her maid was the first person burned at the stake in Ireland at the beginning of Ireland's witch trials. Today it is a place of ceol and craic (music and fun).
	Depart for Killarney stopping at the Rock of Cashel , an Abbey ruin, for a photo op along the way.
	Continue on for your 3 night stay in Killarney and check in at the 4-star International Hotel located within easy walking distance of shops, restaurants, pubs and the jaunting carriages.
	Dinner on your own and free evening in Killarney to explore or take in some live music at a local pub.

Mon May 17	Killarney (B)
	Full Irish Breakfast at the hotel.
	Depart for Dingle Peninsula . Renowned for its dramatic coastal cliffs, ancient archaeological ruins, and vibrant traditional Irish culture. Located along the famous Wild Atlantic Way, it stands out as the westernmost tip of mainland Ireland and features a unique mix of rugged sandy beaches, towering mountain passes, and historic Gaeltacht (Irish-speaking) villages. Enjoy the scenery on the Slea Head Drive around the Dingle Peninsula where you will also enjoy lunch on your own and free time to explore the shops and beach in Dingle Town .
	Dingle Sheepdog demo . Watch a local sheep-farmer skillfully working his sheepdogs. The commands are in native Irish with the skill being handed down from generation to generation. Also includes a visit to the historic Famine Cottages. Dating back to the 1800's, the ancestral home of the Kavanagh family remains as it would have appeared during famine times in Ireland.
	Return for another free in Killarney for dinner and live music at a local pub at your leisure, or take a Jaunting Carriage to Ross Castle . (B)
Tue, May 18	Killarney (B, D)
	Full Irish Breakfast at the hotel.
	Ring of Kerry Scenic Drive - First stop Bog Village stop for Irish Coffee. See Skellig Michael where Luke Skywalker was found in the new movies. Photo stops at Moll's Gap and the Ladies View . Stroll a short way from here to the Torc Waterfall .
	Lovely Irish lunch on your own on the drive at Scarriff Inn with expansive coastal views.
	Upon our return to Killarney we have a special Surprise Experience planned for you followed by a group dinner.
Wed, May 19	Galway 2 nights (B) House Hotel - 4 star
	Full Irish Breakfast at the hotel.
	This morning we pack up and head for Galway . You'll enjoy the serene experience of crossing Ireland's mystical Shannon River via Ferry . Named for the Celtic Goddess, it is said she ate the Salmon of Knowledge and her divine power flowed into the water, giving life to the land.
	From there it is on to the Cliffs of Moher which rise 700 feet above the Atlantic. Walking the pathways along the 14km-long cliffs and gazing out at the wild Atlantic Ocean from the viewing platforms feels like experiencing the very essence of Ireland itself. Throughout history, these magnetic cliffs have always drawn people in, inspiring ancient myths and wowing on screen in classics such as The Princess Bride. Lunch on your own at the Cliffs Cafe.
	As we drive toward Galway you will enjoy the wild moonscape of the Burren and expansive views from above Galway Bay .
	Check in at hotel for our 2 night stay at the newly remodeled 4-star House Hotel City Center in the heart of Galway's lively Latin Quarter. Galway - the Bohemia of Ireland - is a shopping, dining and live music mecca of Ireland. There's no other town like it. You have the evening free to explore and enjoy. And for the book lovers among us, be sure to check out Charlie Byrns Bookshop .
Thu May 20	Galway (B)
	Full Irish Breakfast at the hotel.
	Spend the day relaxing and enjoying the sites and sounds in Galway or book an optional excursion to the Aran Islands , 3 rocky isles guarding the mouth of Galway Bay, in western Ireland. They're known for their ancient sites. The largest island, Inishmore , is home to the prehistoric fort of Dún Aonghasa, perched on top of a high cliff. The boat dock is a 15 minute walk or a short taxi ride from our hotel. (Details and pricing will be sent to guests in early 2027.)
	Another option, for those staying in Galway, is a guided walking tour. Learn about Galway's unique Spanish flavor and check out all the city's hidden secrets.
	Meals on your own and day at your leisure.

Fri, May 21	Dublin Airport 1 night (B, D) Clayton Hotel - 4 star
	Full Irish Breakfast at the hotel.
	After leaving Galway's western coast, we head back toward Dublin with a stop at historic Kilbeggan Distillery for a Tour & Tasting . Kilbeggan was founded in 1757, the oldest licensed Whiskey distillery in Ireland is a story of Irish legacy and triumph. After closing in the 1950s, determination and grit brought the old granddad back to life, resuming distilling in 2007, just in time for its 250th anniversary.
	With a warm glow, you'll journey to tiny Kildare Town's renowned Newbridge Silverware and its impressive gift shop, cafe and Museum of Hollywood Icons . Lunch on your own in the Newbridge Cafe.
	You'll arrive at our final hotel near the Dublin airport with time to refresh before we head to your Farewell Dinner at Man O' War Pub . Established in 1732, it is one of the oldest pubs in Ireland.
	Return to 4-star Clayton Dublin Airport Hotel for your final night stay. Conveniently located near the airport with a complementary shuttle for morning departure.
Sat, May 22	Fly home (B)
	Full Irish Breakfast at the hotel.
	Take the hotel shuttle to the airport. And as we depart... May the road rise up to meet you. May the wind be always at your back. May the sun shine warm upon your face and the wind fall soft upon your fields. And until we meet again, may God hold you in the palm of His hand.

Cancellations and Refunds

Cancellation fees apply to the entire booking, including tour fare, air add-ons, ground transfers, pre- and post- hotel and tour packages. If any components are canceled, you will be responsible for any cancellation fees imposed by the airlines, other transportation carriers, other tour and ground operators, and other hotel properties. You are not entitled to any refund, payment, compensation, or credit except as otherwise provided in this Section. Any refunds will be made directly to the method of payment you used at the time of booking or your travel agent and you must receive your refund directly from these sources. Guests who cancel in writing as set forth below within the dates shown below for any reason, including medical or family reasons, are subject to the following per-person cancellation fees, as applicable.

You hereby agree that losses sustained by Prime Tours in the event of your cancellation would be very difficult or impossible to quantify and that the fees set forth in the below cancellation schedule represent a fair and reasonable assessment as liquidated damages. Since a cancellation likely means a diminished opportunity to sell the same space on other cruises or trips, the cancellation fees below apply regardless of a name change or stateroom resale.

All requests for cancellation must be received in writing. Cancellations cannot be made online. Cancellations received 180 days or more prior to departure, or as stated in your trip flier, are refundable less an administrative fee of a minimum US \$50 per person, or as stated in your trip flier. Disabilities and Special Needs
