	Depart Columbus for flight to San Francisco
9:00 AM	Meet & greet your California Tours guide by baggage claim
	Travel to the Golden Gate Bridge for breathtaking views of the bay. The Golden Gate Bridge was the longest suspension bridge in the world when it opened in 1937 and remains one of California's most recognizable landmarks.
	Lunch on own in the waterfront village of Sausalito known for its stunning bay views, historic floating houseboats, and waterfront dining
	Continue into the heart of Napa Valley for an introductory driving tour of downtown Napa, showcasing its vibrant restaurants, boutiques, and historic architecture.

	Journey through the scenic Carneros Carneros American Viticultural Area (AVA) , known for its cool climate vineyards and exceptional Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. Obtaining its AVA status in 1983, Carneros was the first wine region in California to be classified by its climate characteristics rather than political boundaries.
	Enjoy a private cave tour & tasting with Kunde Family Winery . The vineyards on this land were initially planted in 1879 by Captain John Drummond, using imported cuttings from Chateaux Margaux and Lafite Rothschild. Today, the ranch is managed by fourth and fifth generation Kunde family members. With over 20 varieties, a 1,000-foot elevation change, seven unique microclimates, and two AVAs, the Wildwood and Kinneybrook Ranches are truly one of a kind, with the Kunde family proudly serving as stewards of the land.
	Embark on a driving tour of historic Sonoma Square which is the largest historic town square in California and was the site where the short-lived California Republic was declared during the Bear Flag Revolt in 1846
	Lunch on your own in Sonoma Square
	After lunch, join a private tasting with the Donum Estate known for its world-class estate-grown wines specializing in chardonnay and pinot. The Donum Estate includes nearly 60 monumental artworks making it one of the world's largest private outdoor sculpture collections.
	Depart Donum for dinner on your own in Downtown Napa

9:30 AM	Depart hotel for a narrated driving tour of Silverado Trail for Napa Wine Country AVA . Napa Valley is home to more than 400 wineries and was designated America's first Agricultural Preserve in 1968, helping protect its vineyards from urban development.
	Participate in a private tour and tasting with Castillo di Amorosa known for specializing in Italian varietal wines.
	Lunch on your own at St. Helena in the heart of Napa Valley and known as the area's "Main Street" for its vibrant culinary scene and historic downtown boutiques
	After lunch, join a private tasting with Robert Mondavi Winery specializing in Napa chardonnay and cabernet from Oakville AVA
	Drop off at Yountville for dinner on your own in the charming, 1.5-square-mile town in California's Napa Valley. Renowned as the culinary heart of Wine Country, it boasts more Michelin stars per capita than anywhere else in North America. The area is highly walkable and packed with world-class dining, luxury boutique inns, and premier tasting rooms.

	Tour Lombard Street , "the crookedest street in the world," featuring eight steep, sharp hairpin turns and paved with red bricks. Continue the tour to North Beach known as San Francisco's "Little Italy."
	Lunch on your own in North Beach, one of San Francisco's premier cultural and culinary hubs
	Discover San Francisco on an afternoon walking tour showcasing some of the city's most iconic neighborhoods and waterfront attractions. Stroll through the bustling streets of historic Chinatown , the oldest Chinatown in North America, where colorful architecture, traditional markets, and authentic eateries reflect generations of Chinese heritage. Continue along the scenic Embarcadero , San Francisco's lively waterfront boulevard lined with public art, historic piers, and sweeping views of the Bay Bridge and Alcatraz Island . Cancellations and Refunds

Cancellation fees apply to the entire booking, including tour fare, air add-ons, ground transfers, pre- and post- hotel and tour packages.
