	Tuesday October 26, 2027 (D)
Morning	Your adventure begins as you meet your fellow travelers and Prime Tours guide and board the motorcoach at Blendon Senior Center. Settle in as we head south toward the Bluegrass State. There will be one comfort stop along the way.
	Step into the home of America's most famous baseball bat on a guided tour at Louisville Slugger Museum & Factory . Watch skilled craftsmen turn billets of ash and maple into Louisville Slugger bats used by professional players, explore interactive exhibits celebrating baseball's greatest legends, and pose with the world's largest baseball bat standing 120 feet tall outside the museum.
	Enjoy a lunch on your own in downtown Louisville.
	After lunch, head to the Frazier Kentucky History Museum for a guided tour that tells the fascinating story of Kentucky through engaging exhibits, artifacts, and interactive displays. As the Official Starting Point of the Kentucky Bourbon Trail®, the museum also explores bourbon's rich heritage and its impact on Kentucky's culture and economy.
	End the day with an included dinner at one of Kentucky's oldest Group Dinner at Talbott Tavern and most legendary inns. Established in 1779, the Talbott Tavern has welcomed travelers for more than two centuries, including famous guests such as Daniel Boone, Abraham Lincoln, and Jesse James. Its historic atmosphere and classic Kentucky cuisine make for a memorable evening.

7:30 AM	Breakfast at the hotel
	Check out and depart for Bardstown Bourbon Company to join a guided tour and tasting at one of Kentucky's newest and most innovative distilleries. Learn about the distillation process, aging techniques, and the craftsmanship behind producing award-winning bourbons. Afterwards, enjoy time to browse the gift shop.
	Climb aboard the beautifully restored vintage railcars of My Old Kentucky Home Train and enjoy an included lunch as you travel on tracks that have served central Kentucky for well over 150 years. You'll roll through the scenic countryside surrounding Bardstown with views of horse farms, rolling hills, and historic landscapes. This is a two-hour excursion offering a relaxing glimpse into Kentucky's railroading past.

Terms and Conditions

Cancellations and Refunds

Cancellation fees apply to the entire booking, including tour fare, air add-ons, ground transfers, pre- and post- hotel and tour packages. Guests who cancel in writing as set forth below within the dates shown below for any reason, including medical or family reasons, are subject to the following per-person cancellation fees, as applicable.

You hereby agree that losses sustained by Prime Tours in the event of your cancellation would be very difficult or impossible to quantify and that the fees set forth in the below cancellation schedule represent a fair and reasonable assessment as liquidated damages. Since a cancellation likely means a diminished opportunity to sell the same space on other cruises or trips, the cancellation fees below apply regardless of a name change or stateroom resale.

All requests for cancellation must be received in writing. Cancellations cannot be made online. Cancellations received 180 days or more prior to departure, or as stated in your trip flyer, are refundable less an administrative fee of a minimum US \$50 per person, or as stated in your trip flyer. If cancellation occurs after the non-refundable date, all payments are forfeited, unless otherwise stated in your trip flyer. If full payment has not yet been received, the full penalty will still apply and any unpaid balance is due immediately.

Liability Statement

Itinerary Changes

However, should improvements be made and/or unforeseen conditions beyond our control deem change necessary; we reserve the right to do so. This may result in varying itineraries and substitute facilities or attractions of equivalent or better value. In the event of national or local holidays, certain listed features i.e. museums, attractions, etc., may be affected or unavailable. If the cancellation of a scheduled activity is encountered, we will endeavor to provide a suitable substitute if at all possible.

Disabilities and Special Needs

Prime Tours makes every effort to contract with providers of transportation which fully comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act. If you have special travel or accommodation needs, you must notify us in writing as to the nature of any special accommodations or needs you

may require. Prime Tours nor any of the providers of transportation, lodging, or entertainment can ensure special accommodations without advance notice. Passengers requiring special assistance, including without limitation those who permanently or periodically use a wheelchair, must be accompanied by someone who is fit and able to assist them, and who will be completely responsible for providing all required assistance. The right is reserved to decline to accept or retain any person as a member of this trip who, in the opinion of Prime Tours, is unfit for travel or whose physical or mental condition may constitute a danger to themselves or to others on the trip.

Changes Due to External Events Beyond Prime Tours Control

For this reservation, I/we requested that Prime Tours, an independently owned and operated travel business, book travel arrangements on my/our behalf. Travel Insurance

After that, if you or Prime Tours cancels the trip, your premium will be non-refundable, but can be transferred to another trip within 12 or more months depending on the insurance company.
