September 1, 2026 - Fly Overnight

Depart the USA for an overnight flight to Edinburgh.

September 2, 2026 - Edinburgh - 2 nights - [Radisson Blu Hotel, Edinburgh City Centre](#)

Arrive in Edinburgh. Meet Blue Badge and motor coach and begin the tour with a stop at **The Kelpies**, world's largest equine statues.

The head to **Stirling Castle**, Grounds and Cemetery, one of Scotland's most historically important sites and was once a favored residence of the Stuart kings and queens who held grand celebrations at the castle.

Depart for Hotel

Check into the **Radisson Blu** in the heart of the Royal Mile. Group dinner at TBD.

September 3, 2026 Edinburgh (B, D)

Breakfast at the hotel. Walking tour of Edinburgh ending with admission and touring of Edinburgh Castle (with afternoon at leisure).

Double Dead Walking Tour in the evening. Dinner on your own.

September 4, 2026 - Inverness (B) - 2 nights - [Royal Highland Hotel](#)

Breakfast at hotel

Depart for Glamis Castle - We will start our journey to the Highlands with admission to and a self guided tour of **Glamis Castle**, Grounds and Gardens. Glamis has a deep connection to today's Royal Family as it was the childhood home of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth and birthplace of Princess Margaret. Once host to Mary, Queen of Scots, Glamis is said to have inspired one of Shakespeare's most famous plays, Macbeth. King Malcolm III of Scotland, was murdered on the site of the castle. Later the castle was occupied by Cromwell's troops in 1650. Janet Douglas, Lady Glamis, was found guilty of treason and was burnt at the stake in front of Edinburgh Castle 1537. She is said to haunt Glamis Castle along with several other Spirits. They call her the Gray Lady. She has been seen numerous times in the castle chapel. It is believed there are 6 known ghosts on the property.

Depart for Pitlochry

Lunch in Pitlochry - In the heart of Scotland with real hospitality, clear sparkling air, beautiful scenery, rich clan history. Depart for Inverness.

The **Clava Cairns** are about 4,000 years old and were built to house the dead. The cemetery remained a sacred place in the landscape for millennia and provides many clues to the beliefs of Bronze Age society. (note subject to bus accessibility to this remote site).

Check in at **The Royal Highland** historic Inverness Hotel - dinner on your own and evening at leisure.

September 5, 2026 - Inverness (B)

Breakfast at hotel

Boat Ride on beautiful Loch Ness and search for Nessie. Deboard at historic Urquhart Castle -magnificently situated on the shore of Loch Ness, has seen some of the most dramatic chapters in our nation's story.

Lunch on your own in Inverness.

In the afternoon we will take a trip to **The Battlefield That Changed Scottish History - Battle of Culloden** (April 16, 1746), the final confrontation of the Jacobite Rising and one of the most significant battles in British history. The battle marked the end of the Jacobite cause, led by Prince Charles Edward Stuart.

Return to hotel - evening/dinner on your own

September 6, 2026 - Kirkwall (B, D) - 2 nights - [Albert Hotel](#)

Breakfast at hotel, checkout and head north to the Orkney Island Ferry.

Arrive at Scrabster Ferry Terminal - Ferry departs at 1:15 PM - Check in closes at 12:45 PM

Arrive in Stromness Orkney Islands. Welcome to **The Orkney Islands** ~ an ancient culture where mermaids sing and fin men take human brides. Giants dance here, and the terrible Nuckelavee haunts the lonely shores.

Check in the **Albert Hotel in Kirkwall**, Orkney Islands

Optional for extra fee - Highland Park Whisky Tasting - The Orkney Island Distillery. Hear the story of Highland Park and sample their whisky.

Group dinner at our hotel

September 7, 2026 - Kirkwall (B)

Breakfast at hotel

Depart hotel for **tour of the island** including the Heart of Neolithic Orkney, a group of Neolithic monuments on Orkney consists of a large chambered tomb (Maes Howe), two ceremonial stone circles (the Stones of Stenness and the Ring of Brodgar) and a settlement (Skara Brae), together with a number of un-excavated burial, ceremonial and settlement sites. The group constitutes a major prehistoric cultural landscape which gives a graphic depiction of life in this remote archipelago in the far north of Scotland some 5,000 years ago. Lunch at Stromness (on your own).

St Magnus Cathedral (and cemetery) in Kirkwall, Built 1137. During its long history, the cathedral has been used to dry Viking sails and as a prison for accused witches and other 'criminals.' It has played unwilling host to Cromwell's troops and seen more weddings, funerals and burials within its walls than can be known. St. Magnus is surrounded by burial plots, wonderful old iron fences and beautiful headstones.

Hotel Kirkwall & dinner on your own and evening at leisure.

September 8, 2026 - Fort Augustus (B) - 1 Night - The Inch Hotel or The Lovat Hotel

Breakfast at hotel, checkout and depart for the ferry back to the Highlands.

Arrive at ferry terminal - Check in closes at 10:30AM - Ferry departs at 11:00 AM

Arrive in Thurso/Scrabster and head south towards Ft. Augustus on Loch Ness. Comfort Stop tbd

Arrive in Ft. Augustus, a village in the Scottish Highlands, situated on the southern shore of Loch Ness, about halfway between Inverness and Fort William. It's a popular destination for its scenic location, outdoor activities, and historical sites. The village is known for its Caledonian Canal locks, the historic Fort Augustus Abbey

The Highland Hotels are small so our group will split into either The Inch Hotel or The Lovat Hotel.

September 9, 2026 - Edinburgh Airport (B, D) - 1 Night - [DoubleTree by Hilton Edinburgh Airport](#)

Breakfast at hotel, checkout and depart for Glencoe.

Scenic drive through the **Glencoe National Park** - "Murder! Massacre! Betrayal! Treason!" Glencoe is one of the most spectacular areas of unspoiled wilderness in Scotland. There is a haunting quality about the moor-clad mountains that stand as sentinels over the eight-mile-long glen which runs from east to west along the northern border of Argyll." Lunch Inveraray.

Inveraray Jail is an 1820 prison that housed men, women and children in cramped overcrowded cells. Over 6,000 souls were imprisoned in this small jail. Some spirits have never left....The jail houses a Torture, Death and Damnation exhibit, a county courtroom and jail cells. Inveraray Jail has been featured on several TV shows including Britain's "Most Haunted
