

## CRO Scoring Tool

### I- Initial Preparation

- Before CRO proposals arrive, customize the EXCEL file to meet your needs regarding additional categories and perhaps consider including notes on cultural fit and other “soft” criteria.
- Brief your review team (if multiple people are scoring) on the evaluation categories and scoring criteria. This tool uses a scoring of 1 to 5.

### II. Scoring Each Proposal

For each CRO:

#### Step 1:

Review the full proposal carefully, paying special attention to how they address each major category (Experience, Clinical Strategy, Operations, etc.).

#### Step 2:

For each evaluation category:

- Assign a score between 1 and 5:
  - 5 = Excellent (fully meets or exceeds expectations)
  - 4 = Very Good (meets expectations with minor gaps)
  - 3 = Good (adequate, but with noticeable gaps)
  - 2 = Fair (significant concerns)
  - 1 = Poor (does not meet requirements)

#### Step 3:

- Enter the score into the “Score (1-5)” this column is shaded in blue in the file.
- For each row in the worksheet, the score will calculate (Score × Weight (%)) to get the “Weighted Score” for that line item. The total score will fall between 1 to 5, with a score of 1 being the lowest, and 5 the highest

#### Step 4:

- Sum the weighted scores to get a Total Score for each CRO. The total score for each CRO will fall between 1 to 5, with a score of 1 being the lowest, and 5 the highest

### III. Comparison Across CROs

- Compare Total Scores across all CROs.
- Review any especially high or low category scores to understand where key differences lie.
- Consider qualitative factors as well (gut feeling about cultural fit, enthusiasm, responsiveness).

## IV. Recommendation Step

Use your findings to:

- Shortlist: Select top 2 CROs for final due diligence / presentations
- Select: Recommend a single CRO to move forward
- Decline: Politely decline CROs that don't meet minimum threshold
