





LNG Technical Work

- Marcogaz Technical Groups are currently preparing the Work Program for the coming year. This is a good opportunity to get input from our stakeholders, including GIIGNL, on potential joint technical assessment on LNG.
- ♠ The planned/ongoing work include:
 - ↑ Technical assessment of the GAS QUALITY of imported LNG due to diversification of sources after the energy crisis.
 - **1** The future role of existing LNG assets, like LNG terminals with low carbon gases.





Political Guidelines on Energy European Commission



- The New European Commission has made public its Energy objectives for the coming five years.
- ♠ These Objectives will be aligned with Draghi Report which is addressing European competitiveness and the future of the European Union.
- Among the objectives presented by the Commission, some will impact the LNG in medium-long term, particularly:
 - 1. Legal framework for European grids for electronification
 - 2. Clean industrial deal for competitive industries focusing on decarbonization
 - 3. Acceleration of deployment of small modular reactors and ensuring nuclear safety
 - 4. Industrial carbon management strategy CCS
