

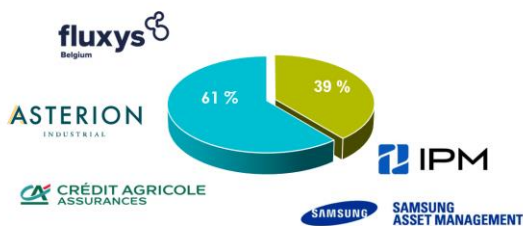
dunkerque LNG fluxys

Dunkerque LNG owns the Dunkerque LNG terminal, located in northern France. It is one of the largest terminals in Europe and has an annual regasification capacity of 13 BCM, representing between 20% and 30% of annual French and Belgian natural gas consumption.



Changes in company shareholding

Asterion Industrial Partners, an independent investment management firm focused on infrastructure investments in the European mid-market, indirectly acquired a 15% stake in Dunkerque LNG.



Description of current LNG activities

- 75 vessels unloaded during the first half-year 2025.

- Close to 80 TWh regasified
- 1 030 trucks loaded in the first half of the year

Notable deals or key events

ConocoPhillips has secured 1.5 million tons per annum of regasification capacity at the terminal, starting in 2028.

Latest developments and projects

BioLNG

Dunkerque LNG has been ISCC certified for mass-balanced BioLNG conversion (also known as "Equivalence liquefaction") and the first converted volumes have been loaded into trucks.

Liquid CO₂ terminal

Dunkerque LNG is part of a joint initiative to build a Carbon Capture and Storage chain (*Cap Décarbonation*), carried out in collaboration with Air Liquide, Eciom (cement) and Lhoist (lime). Co-founded by the European Union.

The CO₂ terminal will have a capacity of 1,5 mtpa and expandable
