2. Other Topics

In March 2025, JAPEX has concluded a collaboration agreement with partners (individuals) who have a long history of experience in the US E&P business and a successful track record in the private equity business to acquire and operate assets in the US E&P business through JAPEX's overseas consolidated subsidiary JAPEX (U.S.) Corp. (hereinafter "JUS"), and has established Peoria Resources LLC (hereinafter "Peoria") with JUS and the partners. JAPEX is participating in the US E&P business (tight oil development) and the Freeport LNG project as a non-operator through JUS. By concluding the collaboration agreement, JAPEX and JUS aim to acquire and strengthen the ability to develop and operate US E&P businesses as an operator with partners in Peoria, and to ensure the acquisition and operation of operator assets.
