Activity Report (Nippon Gas Co., Ltd.)

1. Gas Sales Results

Natural gas sales volume in FY2024 was approximately 100 million m3 (46.04655MJ/m3), increased by 2.2% from the previous fiscal year.

The followings are the details:

- ✓ Gas sales volume for residential use decreased by 1.1% compared to the previous fiscal year, due to the widespread adoption of energy conservation among households and the low demand for gas-powered heating systems, as the average temperature remained high throughout the fiscal year.
- ✓ Gas sales volume for non-residential use, such as commercial, industrial, and other uses, increased by 3.2% compared to the previous year, due to our continued efforts to expand business and the growing demand for gas-powered heating and air-conditioning systems amid recent extreme climate conditions.

2. LNG Sales Results

LNG sales volume in FY2024 was approximately 76,500 tons, slightly increased by 4.0% supported by LNG lorry sales, compared to the previous fiscal year.

3. LNG Procurement

We received approximately 146,000 tons of LNG in total in FY2024.

The followings are the details:

- ✓ We indirectly imported 4 LNG cargoes from Australia, 1 LNG cargo from Papua New Guinea and 1 LNG cargo from Indonesia under the cooperation of Osaka Gas Co., Ltd. and Kyushu Electric Power Co., Inc. We purchased LNG partially from those cargoes, totaling approximately 133,000 tons.
- ✓ In total, we purchased 146,000 tons of LNG in FY2024, including LNG lorry from Oita Liquefied Natural Gas Company, Inc.
