1. Changes in company leadership since the last General Assembly

- Kojiro Higuchi appointed as Chairman and Representative Director as of April 1, 2025
- Kazuhiro Ishiyama appointed as President and Representative Director as of April 1, 2025

2. Electricity Sales Volume and Power Source Composition

In fiscal year 2024, our electricity sales volume reached 78 billion kWh, a decrease of 1.6% compared to the previous year.

Additionally, the power source composition for the electricity sold in fiscal year 2024 was as follows:

Coal: 34%, Gas: 31%, Nuclear: 3%, Hydroelectric (over 30,000 kW): 3%, and New Energy and Others: 29%.

3. LNG Procurement of Tohoku Electric

Currently, our company procures approximately 4 million tons of LNG annually from countries such as Malaysia, Qatar, Russia, Australia, and the United States, through a combination of long-term, short-term, and spot contracts.

Looking ahead, we will continue to optimize our LNG procurement volume in response to changes in the electricity market and efforts toward carbon neutrality.

4. Key Events

☑ In October 2024, at Unit 5-1 of the Niigata Thermal Power Station (Niigata City, Niigata Prefecture, 54,500 kW), we conducted a hydrogen co-firing test in which hydrogen was mixed with the existing fuel (LNG) and combusted in a gas turbine to generate electricity. We achieved a hydrogen co-firing ratio of approximately 8% by volume, the highest level attained with our equipment.

② In December 2024, Unit 2 of our Onagawa Nuclear Power Station resumed commercial operation for the first time in approximately 14 years. This is expected to contribute to stable power supply and reduction of CO₂ emissions.
