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Notes to Non-consolidated Financial Statements

Significant Accounting Policies

1. Valuation of Securities

Investments in Subsidiaries and Other Securities that do not have readily determinable fair values are valued at cost determined by the moving average method.

Securities Available for Sale with a market price are valued on a mark-to-market basis using the average market price during one-month periods before the balance sheet date (cost of securities sold is calculated primarily by the moving average method). The total unrealized gains(losses) on Securities Available for Sale are booked directly to Shareholder's Equity.

2. Depreciation of Fixed Assets

(a) Tangible Fixed Assets

Depreciation of Buildings is computed by the straight-line method, and that of Equipment is computed by the declining-balance method using the following estimated useful lives.

Buildings: 3 to 38 years

Equipment: 3 to 18 years

(b) Intangible Fixed Assets

Development costs for internally-used software are capitalized and amortized by the straight-line method over their estimated useful lives mainly of 5 years.

3. Deferred Charges

Establishment Costs are capitalized and amortized by the straight-line method over 5 years, in accordance with the Commercial Code of Japan.

4. Reserves

- (1) Reserve for Possible Losses on Investments, which are provided for possible losses on investments, is maintained at the amount deemed necessary based on the financial condition of issuing companies.
- (2) Reserve for Bonus Payment, which is provided for the future bonus payment to employees, is maintained at the amount accrued at the end of the fiscal year, based on the estimated future payment and service periods.
- (3) Reserve for Employee Retirement Benefits, which is provided for the future retirement benefit to employees, is maintained at the amount accrued at the end of the fiscal year, based on estimated balances of the projected benefit obligation and the pension plan assets amounts at the end of this fiscal year.

5. Foreign Currency Items

Assets and liabilities denominated in foreign currencies are translated into Japanese yen at the exchange rates in effect at the balance sheet dates.

6. Leases

Finance leases, which do not involve the transfer of ownership to the lessee at the end of lease terms, are accounted for in the same manner as operating leases.

- 7. Consumption Taxes and local consumption taxes paid are excluded from transaction amounts.
- 8. Effective the fiscal year ended March 31, 2003, Accounting Standard No. 1, "Accounting Standard for Treasury Stock and Reduction of Legal Reserves," is adopted. The effect of this change on net loss was immaterial.
- 9. Effective the fiscal year ended March 31, 2003, Accounting Standard No. 2, "Accounting Standard for Earnings per Share" and Accounting Standard Implementation Guidance No. 4, "Implementation Guidance on Accounting Standard for Earnings per Share" are adopted. There is no effect of this change.
