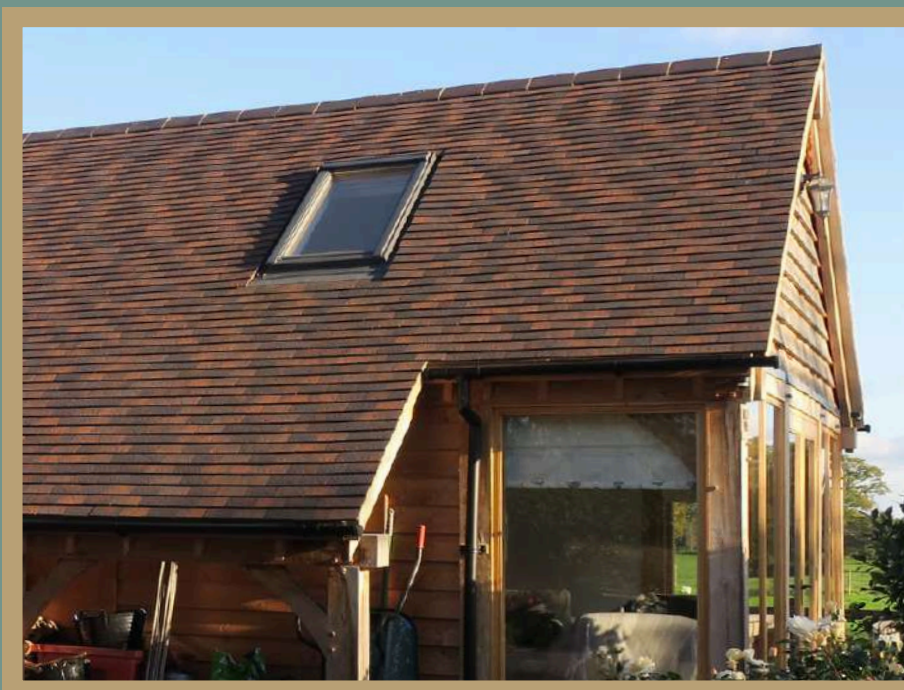

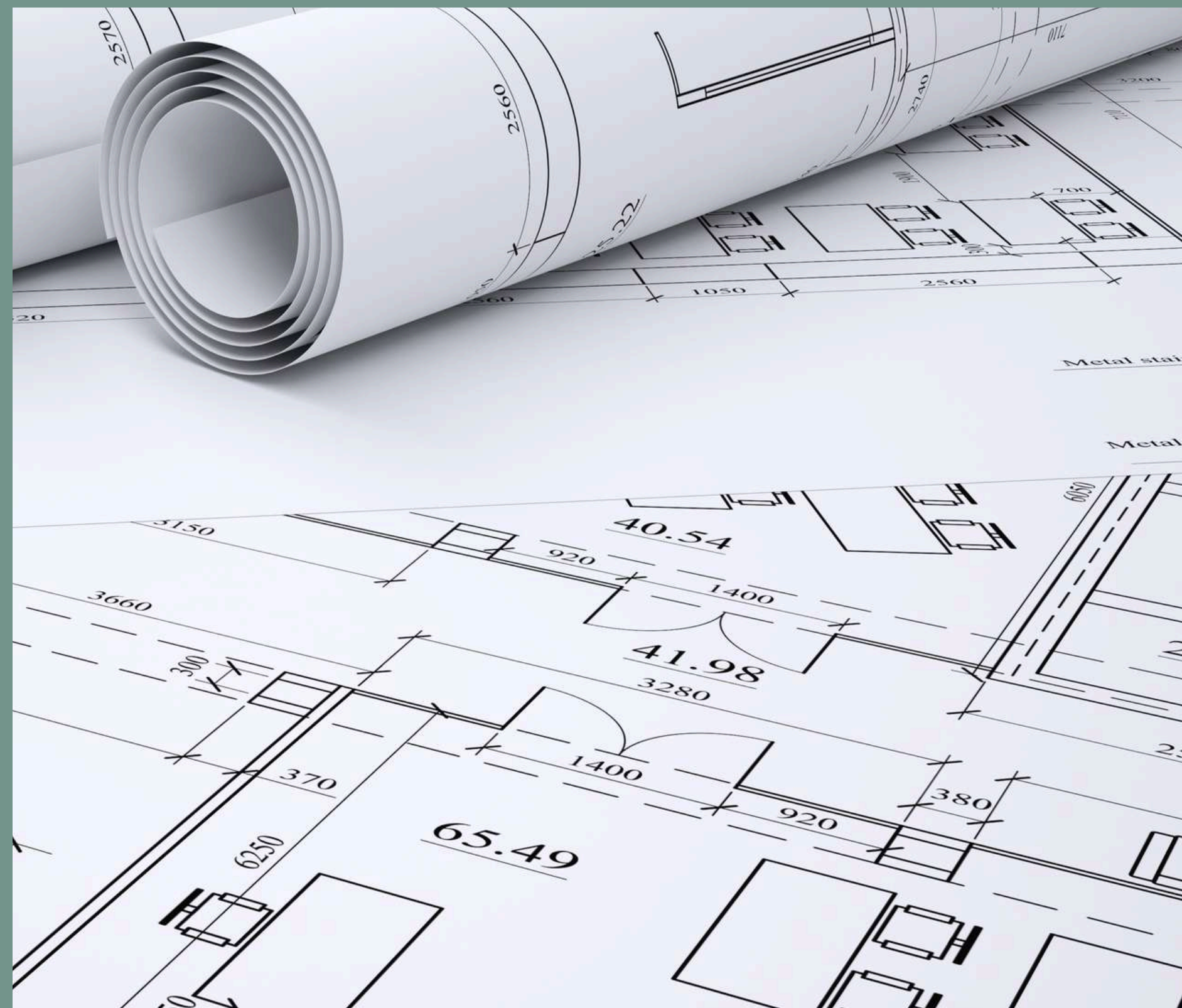
PLANNING PERMISSION
