Where young people do not have an EHCP, we carefully document their normal way of working within our provision and seek support and validation from their host schools.

We maintain consistent and open communication with host schools to ensure a collaborative approach to access arrangements. This partnership allows us to provide robust evidence and ensure that all young people receive the support they are entitled to during formal assessments.
