Summary

In Jesus, God comes close. The Creed confesses Jesus as both fully divine and fully human, revealing the heart of God in a way we can see and know. The incarnation shows that God is not distant or detached but enters into our world, our struggles, and our humanity. To believe in Jesus is not just to agree with ideas about him, but to trust and follow him as Lord.

- Who is Jesus to you personally, beyond what you've been taught?
- What difference does it make that Jesus is both fully God and fully human?
- Where do you find it hard to trust Jesus as Lord in your daily life?
- How might following Jesus shape your priorities or decisions this week?
