SYRIA


In December 2024, the Assad regime collapsed after a 13-year civil war. The same family had ruled for 53 years and was known for its repression, brutality and torture.

Many churches have been destroyed and entire Christian communities have been forced to flee or have been depopulated.

Syrians can trace their biblical heritage back to Aram, a descendent of Shem (Noah's son).

Many Bible stories took place in Syria:

- Paul's conversion in Damascus (Acts 9)
- Naaman's healing (2 Kings 5:1-19)
- Syrian Christians at Tyre (Acts 21:3-7)
