Dear Leaders,

We are going to spend another week in the Samaritan woman's encounter with Jesus. This will be a little different from the usual group meeting. This is necessary to be open to flex and follow Jesus.

For this coming week, I want our people to spend time doing the following:

Read John 4:1-42. Ask the Lord to lead us!

1. What do you remember about the feelings you felt coming to faith? If you came to faith as a young child, think about moments when the gospel became even more powerful to you (your sin/need and God's love both got a lot bigger).
2. Have you experienced the living water of the Spirit "welling up to eternal life" in you? If so, what is it like? If not, how do you feel about that?
3. Have you experienced doing the will of the Father being your food? What has that been like? If not, how do you feel about that?
4. What is inhibiting you from feasting on doing the will of the Father? Be specific. (It's not because you are too busy...what's underneath that?)

Please leave plenty of time to PRAY!!! Specifically pray for the Spirit to well up into eternal life in you. Pray for the ability to feast on doing the will of the Father. Pray for much fruit in sharing Jesus with your life and words. Pray against the enemy's work in each others lives and against any inhibitors to sharing the love of Christ!
