SB 1383 Requirements

Senate Bill 1383 took effect on January 1, 2022. Enforcement of this State law is a collaborative effort between AVI, the City of Dublin and StopWaste. Here are some tips for success in complying with SB 1383.

- All businesses must subscribe to recycling, garbage, and compost collection.
- Place color-coded and labeled recycling and compost bins next to all garbage bins (not required in restrooms).
- Business owners are required to train all employees, tenants, and contractors on the collection requirements within 14 days of hiring or move in and keep a record of training and on-site monitoring to assure compliance.

The Importance of Your Compost Bin


Sorting organics from the landfill:

- Reduces greenhouse gas emissions.
- Extends land fill capacity.
- Creates compost, a nutrient rich amendment, for farmers to grow the fruits and vegetables we eat.

Clean compost leads to clean soil. Please make sure all staff knows what goes into the compost bin.

Acceptable: Food scraps, food-soiled paper, grass/weed clippings, shrub/tree prunings (under 4" diameter), leaves, plants, and flowers.

Not-Acceptable: Household garbage, plastic bags, dirt/rocks, over filled carts (lid must close).



Food Donation

Donating excess food waste reduces waste and provides a needed resource for our community. Remember, under SB 1383, if your business is a Tier One or Tier Two generator you are required to donate any surplus food to food recovery organizations (e.g. food banks, food pantries, soup kitchens, etc.)
