How to Recycle Household Batteries

- ✓ Place accepted batteries—alkaline (AAA, AA, C, D, 9V), lithium coin batteries, and rechargeable NiMH batteries—in a sealed, heavy-duty plastic bag.
- ✓ Set the bag on top of your recycling cart on your regular collection day.

Why It Matters

When batteries end up in the garbage, recycling, or compost, they can ignite when crushed, causing truck fires and putting drivers and neighborhoods at risk. They can also leak toxic metals that can harm our soil and water.
