How to Recycle Household Batteries

- Place all accepted batteries (alkaline AAA, AA, C, D, 9V, lithium coin batteries, and rechargeable NiMH batteries) inside your designated battery receptacle.

- If you cannot find the receptacle on-site, please contact your property manager for assistance.

Why It Matters

When batteries end up in the garbage, recycling, or compost, they can ignite when crushed, causing truck fires and putting drivers and neighborhoods at risk. They can also leak toxic metals that can harm our soil and water.
